#### **David and Bathsheba**

Scriptures: 2 Samuel 11 & 12

Key Verse: 2 Samuel 11:27... But the thing that David had done displeased the Lord"

#### **Key Points:**

- 1. David saw a beautiful woman, Bathsheba, bathing from his rooftop. He inquired about her, sent messengers to get her, and then treated her as his own wife. She did not belong to David, however, she had her own husband Uriah.
- 2. David feared Uriah so he had Joab, the leader of the army, put him at the front of the battle and Uriah was killed. Bathsheba mourned her husband, but when her mourning was over she became David's wife and had a son.
- 3. Nathan, the Lord's prophet, came to David with a story about a ewe lamb. (recount this story) Nathan told David his taking Bathsheba from her husband was just as bad as the man who had taken the lamb. God was very displeased with him. David admitted his sin, however, his son died as his punishment.
- 4. David mourns his son, comforts Bathsheba, then has another son, Solomon, who the Lord loved. Because of David's sin, he experiences many years of unfortunate consequences.







David wanted to marry Bathsheba, but he couldn't because she had a husband. So David sent a terrible message to Joab, the commander of his army.




