
### Week 81 Solomon Becomes King – King David Dies

Scriptures: 1 Kings 1 – 1 Kings 2:12

Key Verse: 1 Kings 2:3 "Keep the charge of the Lord your God: to walk in His ways, to keep His statutes, His commandments, His judgments, His testimonies, as it is written in the Law of Moses, that you may prosper in all that you do and wherever you turn."

### **Key Points:**

- 1. David was old and feeble. His son Adonijah was as handsome and persuasive as Absalom. He attempts to take the throne as David's death is coming. He gets Joab, the head of David's army, and Abithar the priest on his side.
- 2. Nathan, the prophet, hears of this and approaches Bathsheba to go talk to David. Her son Solomon was expected to be David's choice to be his successor.
- **3.** Bathsheba speaks with David and he confirms Solomon is his choice. Zadok the priest and Nathan the prophet anoint Solomon.
- **4.** Adonijah heard and was afraid of Solomon. Solomon agreed to spare his life if he could live respectfully and honorably.
- 5. David gives Solomon words of advice as he takes the throne as king. He tells him to keep the charges and statues of the Lord. His kingdom was "firmly established". Adonijah, and Joab are eventually executed because of their betrayal, Abithar is removed as priest also. David dies and is buried in Jerusalem. David reigned over Israel 40 years.






King David, on death's bed, said to his son Solomon, "Obey the laws of our God in order that you may act wisely."




