Week 87 Elijah on Mount Carmel

Scriptures: 1 Kings 18

Key Verse: 1 Kings 18:37 "Hear me, O Lord, hear me that this people may know that You are the Lord God and that You have turned their hearts back to You again."

Key Points:

- 1. King Ahab was more evil than any king before him. God told Elijah to go to Ahab and He would send rain to end the famine. Obadiah was Ahab's servant who met with Elijah, telling him he was willing to talk to Ahab. Obadiah feared the Lord and believed Elijah was a powerful man of God, however, he also feared that Ahab would kill him if he told him about Elijah.
- 2. Elijah and Ahab meet, Ahab calls Elijah, "O trouble of Israel". Elijah told Ahab he was the one that had troubled Israel by worshiping false gods and forsaking the commands of the Lord. Elijah challenges Ahab to a show of power on Mt. Carmel.
- **3.** All the children of Israel were summoned there, as well as the prophets of Baal. Elijah speaks to Israel asking them how long they will follow these false gods. No one spoke a word.
- 4. Elijah instructed two altars to be built; one for the prophets of Baal and one for him. Bulls were put on the altars, but no fire. Elijah tells Ahab to call to his gods to bring fire. They cried out from morning to evening but there was no fire. Elijah prepared his altar with 12 stones, wood and the bull cut in pieces. Water was poured on it 3 times. Elijah calls on the name of the Lord and God sends fire from heaven and completely consumes the entire altar as well as the water. The people of Israel fell on their faces. God again was victorious. His power was shown that day. The prophets of Baal were captured and executed.
 - 5. In reverence Elijah bowed before God-rain was sent to end the famine.

Elijah's Altar

Materials needed:

Styrofoam cup-62/3 oz. size

Corrugated cardboard—5-inch square

Construction paper—blue and yellow

Lightweight cardboard, such as tagboard

Felt-tip pen

Crayons


White glue


Single-edge razor blade

Directions:

With the razor cut the Styrofoam cup 1½ inches from the top. Wrap a piece of the lightweight cardboard around cup, mark size, and cut. With a black crayon or felt-tip pen, draw stones on this piece. Color stones gray and use brown between stones.

Cut a piece of corrugated cardboard to fit top of altar and glue in place. Glue twigs on altar. Glue stone covering to sides of altar. Allow to dry.





To make base, cut a 4-inch circle out of corrugated square. Cut a 5-inch square of lightweight cardboard and of blue construction paper and glue these together. Then glue corrugated cardboard "soil" on top of "water." Glue altar in center of water. Cut flames of yellow construction paper and edge with orange crayon. Glue onto twigs.

Without water, altar could be used with other Old Testament stories.




ELIJAH AND THE PROPHETS OF BAAL





Elijah's Raven


1 Kings 17:1-7

Materials needed:

Construction paper—black, scrap of red Glue Black thread Crayons or paint

Directions:

Cut two ravens out of black construction paper, and two pieces of meat out of the red paper. (See page 26 for patterns.) Glue raven pieces together, inserting 20-inch piece of thread as indicated. Glue meat between raven's beaks. Add raven's eyes with white crayon or paint. Hang in a window or suspend from the ceiling. Use as a visual or a craft.




Materials needed:

Construction paper—dark green, red, gray, brown, light blue Yarn—dark green Tempera paint Glue

Directions:

Cut twenty-four rocks from gray paper. (See page 24 for all patterns.) Use half of these to form an altar in the lower half of one sheet of green paper. Cut two sacrifices from red paper. Glue one of these on this altar. In second sheet of green paper, punch one hole 1 inch from top and one hole in lower half of paper, where altar will be placed. Glue rest of rocks together to form an altar. Place this over lower hole and glue only around edges. Also glue sacrifice to altar. Paint water around base of altar





with blue paint. Cut from brown paper and glue four barrels around edge as shown in sketch. Cut flame from red paper and add yellow highlights with tempera paints. Glue this to middle of 20-inch piece of green yarn. Thread yarn through holes with flame on top. Cut sky from blue paper and glue this around edges to top of paper. Glue green sheets together, back to back.


As you tell the story, start with the plain altar. Then turn paper over. Keep flame under "sky" until you tell about the fire coming down from Heaven to consume the sacrifice, the rocks, and the water. Then pull yarn, and flame will come down from "Heaven."





Elijah Defeats the Prophets of Baal

Elijah wanted to show the Israelites that God is the one true God so he challenged the prophets of Baal to a contest. Elijah and the prophets of Baal both called on their gods to send fire from heaven, but only Elijah's God answered. The people saw that God answered prayer and Baal could not. After this contest, God sent rain for the first time in more than 3 years.
