God Comforts Elijah

Scriptures: I Kings 19:1-21


Key Verse: 1Ki 19:10 So he said, "I have been very zealous for the LORD God of hosts; for the children of Israel have forsaken Your covenant, torn down Your altars, and killed Your prophets with the sword. I alone am left; and they seek to take my life."

Key Points:

- 1. Jezebel threatened Elijah's life after he had slain the prophets of Baal.
- **2.** Elijah became afraid and ran away.
- 3. An angel provided food and water to sustain Elijah on his journey to Mt. Horeb. He had no other food for 40 days and nights.
- 4. Elijah was discouraged and hid in a cave.
- 5. God demonstrated his presence, not in the wind, an earthquake, or a fire, but in a still small voice.
- 6. God then sent Elijah to anoint two kings, Hazael and Jehu, and to anoint Elisha to be a helper to him.
- 7. Elijah knew that God would protect him to assure that he would be able to complete God's work.
