Scriptures: II Kings 2




## **Key Points:**


- **1.** As the time came for Elijah to go to be with God, Elisha did not want to leave him.
- 2. The sons of the prophets in Bethel, and in Jericho asked Elisha if he knew that his master would be taken from him that day. Elisha replied that he knew but did not want to talk about it.
- **3.** When Elijah and Elisha reached the Jordan River, Elijah rolled up his mantle and when he struck the water, it divided so that they crossed on dry land.
- **4.** Then Elijah asked what he could do for Elisha, and Elisha asked for a double portion of Elijah's power. Elijah said that was a difficult thing, but if Elisha saw Elijah taken away to heaven it would be given to him.
- **5.** Because Elisha witnessed Elijah's departure in the chariot of fire, his request was granted. Elisha picked up Elijah's mantle, rolled it up, struck the water, and crossed back over.
- **6.** The men of Jericho spent three days looking for Elijah, even though Elisha told them Elijah was with God.
- 7. Elisha performed two miracles that confirmed he was God's selected prophet. He restored water for a city. In Bethel, some young people disrespected Elisha because he was bald. Elisha pronounced a curse in the name of the Lord, and bears attacked 42 of the youths.







### Introduction


Wicked King Ahab led the Israelites to worship the idol Baal. Elijah warned Ahab, "God will punish you for sinning. There will be no rain until I say so." It didn't rain for three years, causing a great famine. Elijah proved to the priests of Baal that there is only one real God. Elijah called down fire from heaven. Then he prayed, and the rains fell. King Ahab and Queen Jezebel were very angry with Elijah and wanted to kill him. He had to run for his life. But God protected him and gave Elijah food during the famine.

#### **Directions:**

Trace pattern of map (page 27) on a piece of light green construction paper. Paint lambs and water with the paints. When dry, cover map with the plastic to preserve it. Cut on dotted lines into three pieces. Let the children put the puzzle together and take it apart to show how the people of Israel were to be as sheep without a shepherd.


Use this in a learning center. Have a Bible for the children to read the story. Have a set of two or three simple questions for them to answer. These could be true/false. # Elijah and Elisha Cross the Jordan

2 Kings 2:1-8

#### Materials needed:

Construction paper—green, blue, scrap of color Crayons, felt-tip pens, or tempera paints Clear adhesive-backed plastic Brass paper fastener Glue




#### **Directions:**

Cut two pieces of blue construction paper, 7 inches by 2½ inches. Score and fold each piece 1 inch from end. Trace fish and objects on strips and color. Cover strips with pieces of clear adhesive-backed plastic, leaving the 1-inch tabs. Trace plants, etc., on green paper and color. Trace and cut robe from white or other color. Glue 1-inch tabs of blue strips to backs of green so ends of blue meet in middle of page. Fasten robe above strips of water with brass paper fastener as shown. Use as a visual, "striking" water with robe and turning back water at the proper time in the story.

## Elijah Goes to Heaven

2 Kings 2:9-11



#### Materials needed:

Construction paper—dark blue, white Crayons, felt tip pens, or tempera paints Yarn—dark blue

#### **Directions:**

Trace the picture of Elijah and the chariot and horses (pattern on page 28) onto white construction paper. Color the picture. Punch two holes in the dark blue paper, as shown. Glue the center section of an 18-inch piece of dark blue yarn across the picture. Optional: Cut a second piece of paper to mount on the back of the picture for strength. When dry, thread yarn through the holes. Finish yarn ends with small paper tags. Cut cloud from white paper and glue at top and side edges to background as shown in sketch. Elijah will now "go to Heaven" by sliding the picture under the cloud. Glue a second piece of construction paper under background for durability. Make sure yarn can be moved freely.
