## A Proud King is Humbled

Scriptures: Daniel 4

Key Verse: Dan 4:34-35 And at the end of the time I, Nebuchadnezzar, lifted my eyes to heaven, and my understanding returned to me; and I blessed the Most High and praised and honored Him who lives forever: For His dominion is an everlasting dominion, And His kingdom is from generation to generation. (35) All the inhabitants of the earth are reputed as nothing; He does according to His will in the army of heaven And among the inhabitants of the earth. No one can restrain His hand Or say to Him, "What have You done?"

### **Key Points:**

- 1. King Nebuchadnezzar writes a letter to the entire empire detailing his experiences and praising God.
- 2. Nebuchadnezzar is troubled by a dream; he calls in Daniel to interpret its meaning.
- 3. After relating the dream to Daniel in verses 10-17, Daniel offers the interpretation: Nebuchadnezzar, has built a great earthly kingdom, yet to learn Who truly rules the world, the mighty king will be humbled for a time.
- 4. As he took great pride in the mighty city of Babylon, Nebuchadnezzar heard a voice from heaven pronounce judgment: he would be driven from men and live as a beast for 7 years.
- 5. At the close of that time, Nebuchadnezzar lifted his eyes to heaven, recognizes God, and is restored to the throne.


