## The Writing on the Wall

## Scriptures: Daniel 5

Key Verse: Dan 5:22-23 "But you his son, Belshazzar, have not humbled your heart, although you knew all this. (23) And you have lifted yourself up against the Lord of heaven. They have brought the vessels of His house before you, and you and your lords, your wives and your concubines, have drunk wine from them. And you have praised the gods of silver and gold, bronze and iron, wood and stone, which do not see or hear or know; and the God who holds your breath in His hand and owns all your ways, you have not glorified.

## Key Points:

1. Belshazzar, king of Babylon, throws a great feast for his lords using the utensils and vessels from the temple of God in Jerusalem.
2. As they were feasting, a hand appeared and wrote out a message on the wall of the king's palace.
3. Greatly disturbed by this, the king offers any man in the kingdom a high rank if they can interpret the writing on the wall.
4. The queen suggests Daniel as an interpreter; Daniel is brought in and rebukes the king for his pride.
5. The writing tells the king that the Babylonian empire will come to an end and be succeeded by the Medes and Persians.
6. The king rewards Daniel as promised; that night the city is conquered by the Medo-Persian empire.
