Scriptures: Matthew 4:1-10; Luke 4:1-15


Key Verse: Matthew 4: 4,7,10 "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God; You shall not tempt the Lord your God; You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve."

Key Points:

- 1. Jesus, being full of the Holy Spirit, was led into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil. After Jesus fasted 40 days and 40 nights he was hungry.




Satan Tempts Jesus Matthew 4


