## Scriptures: Matthew 9

Key Verse: Matthew 9:12 "Jesus said, 'Those who are well have no
need of a physician, but those who are sick."

## Key Points:

1. Jesus sees a man named Matthew, who is a tax collector, and says, "Follow me." Matthew obeys. Jesus and His disciples eat meat at Matthew's house, and the Pharisees ask why Jesus is eating with publicans and sinners. Jesus tells them, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick."
2. A certain ruler came and worshipped Jesus, saying that his daughter was dead. He told Jesus to come, lay His hand upon her, and she would live. Jesus and His disciples followed the man home.
3. Two blind men came to Jesus. He asked if they believed that He could heal them, and when they said, "Yes," Jesus touched their eyes and they were opened. When the blind men left, they spread his fame in all the country.
4. Jesus went around to all the cities and villages teaching in the synagogues of the gospel of the kingdom. He healed every sickness and disease among the people.
5. When Jesus saw the multitudes, he had compassion for them because they were like sheep without a shepherd. "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."
