#### **Jesus Helps Those Who Believe**

**Scriptures: John 4**

**Key Verse: John 4:24 “God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship him in spirit and in truth.”**

#### **Key Points:**

1. Jesus came to the land of Samaria on his way to Galilee. Jacob’s well was there and Jesus being tired, went to the well to sit and drink water. A woman from Samaria also came to drink. Jesus asked her to draw water from the well for him. She asked him why he would bother with her being a Samaritan. Jews don’t fellowship with Samaritans. Jesus told her that if she knew who had asked her for a drink, he would have given her “living water”.

2. The woman asked him where would he get this “living water” since he had nothing to draw the water with. Jesus told her anyone drinking His water would never thirst again. Jesus could provide peace and forgiveness that no one else could give. The woman wanted the living water so Jesus told her to take the sin out of her life. She was not living in a way God wanted. Jesus also talked to her about worshiping God. We should worship Him in spirit and in truth. The woman left Jesus and went into the city, telling her relatives about Jesus. Many of them went to him and believed in Jesus because of the testimony of the woman at the well.

3. Jesus then went to Cana. This is where he turned water into wine at a wedding feast, so the miracles of Jesus were well known there. A nobleman from the nearby city of Capernaum had a son who was very ill. He heard about Jesus and went to where he was. He implored Jesus to come visit his son because he had a high fever and was close to death. Jesus told him to go on his way, for his son lived. When he got home, his servant told him “Your son lives”! He asked his servant at what time he son’s fever had left and the servant told him. It was at the same time the man had seen Jesus. So the nobleman believed along with his whole household.

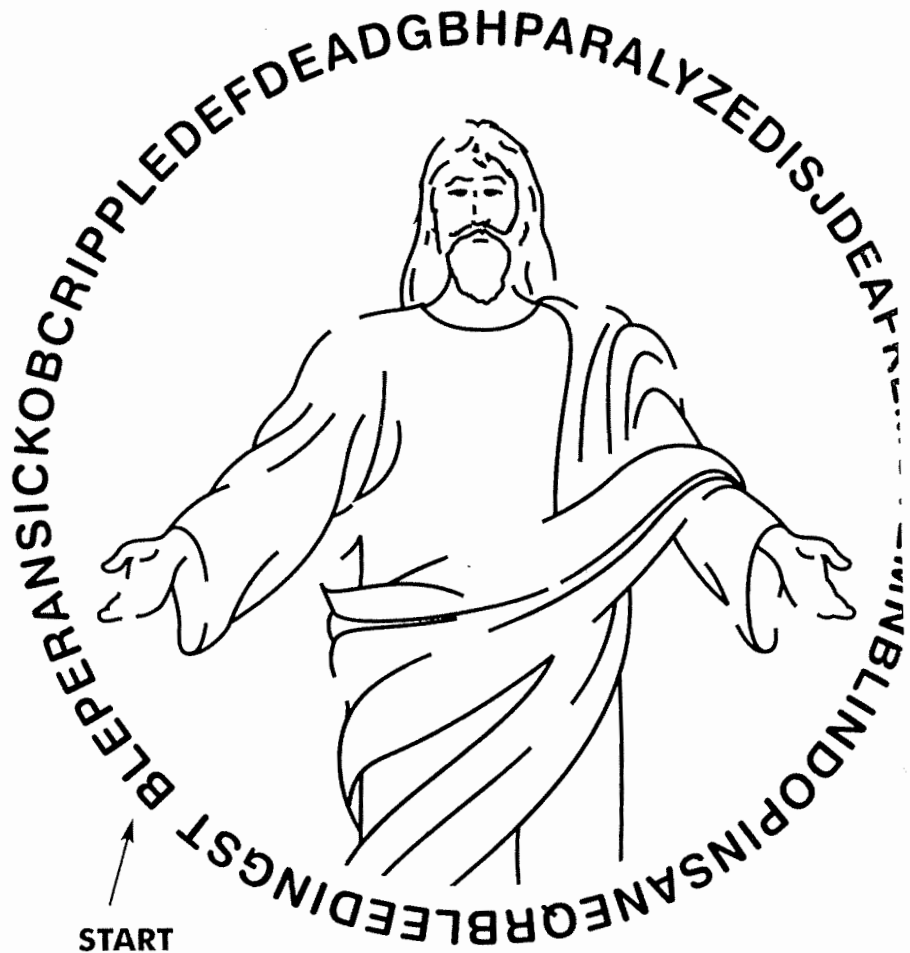

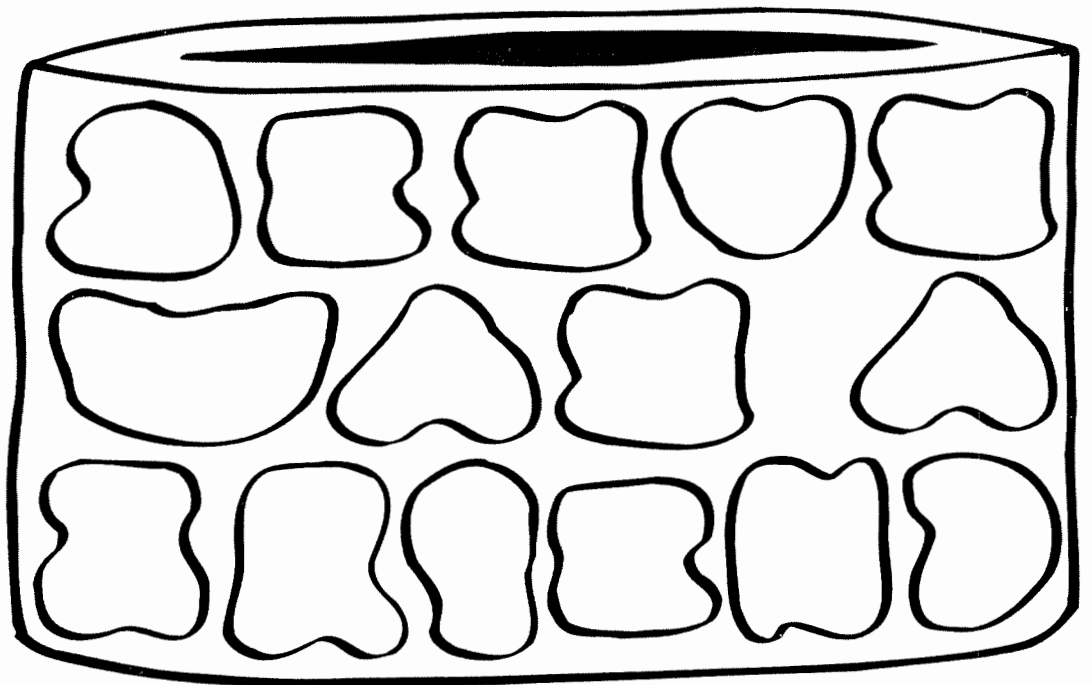
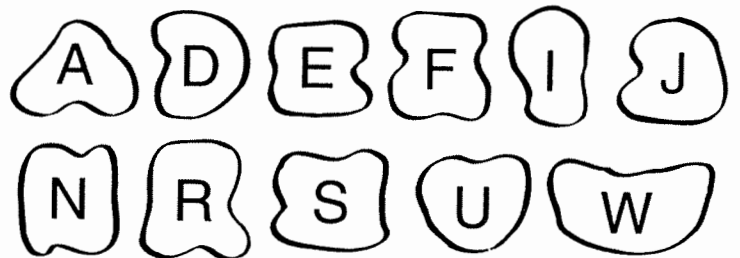

For each stone in the well, find the stone in the code that exactly matches it. Write the letter from the code in the matching stone to find out why Jesus talked to this woman.



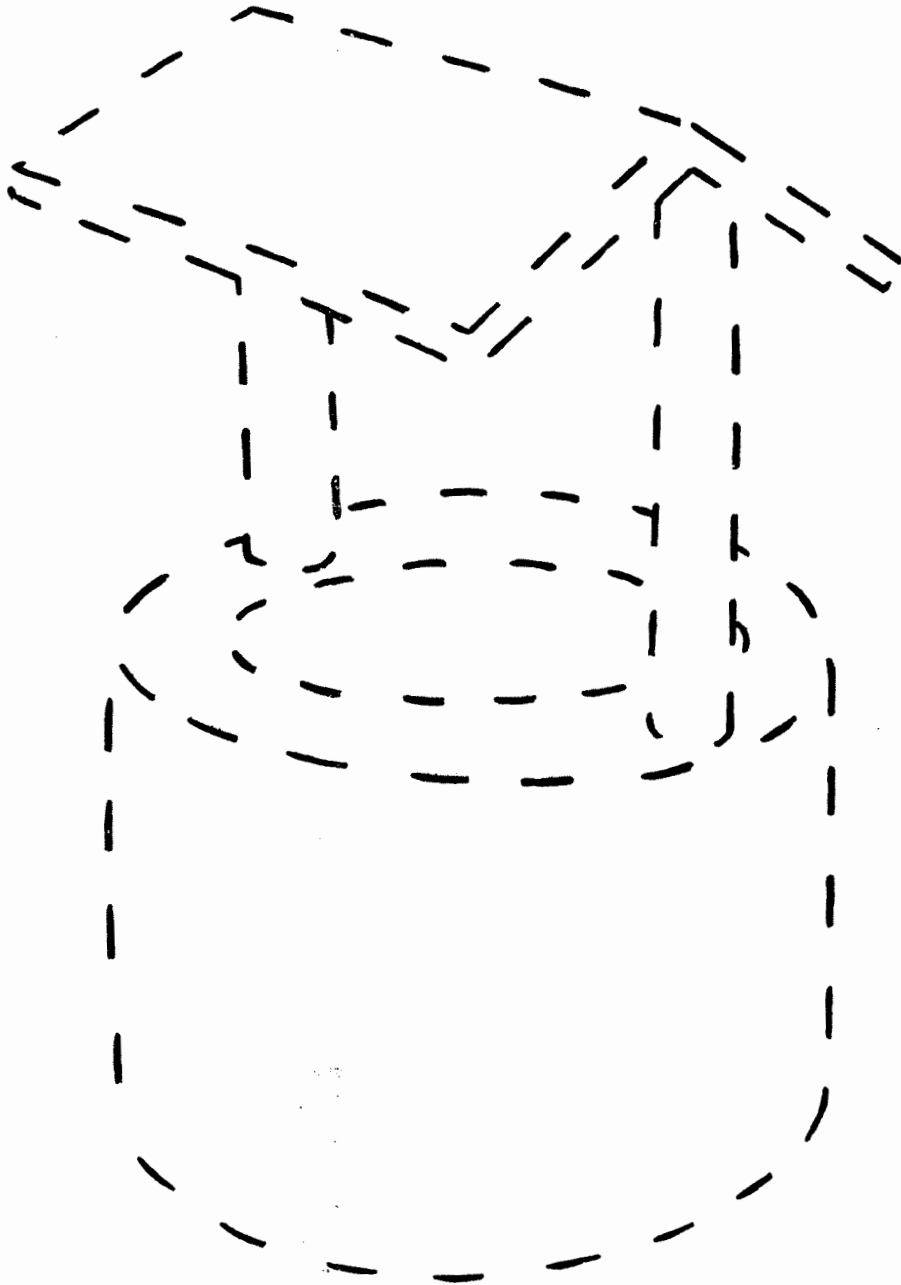

(John 4:3-42)

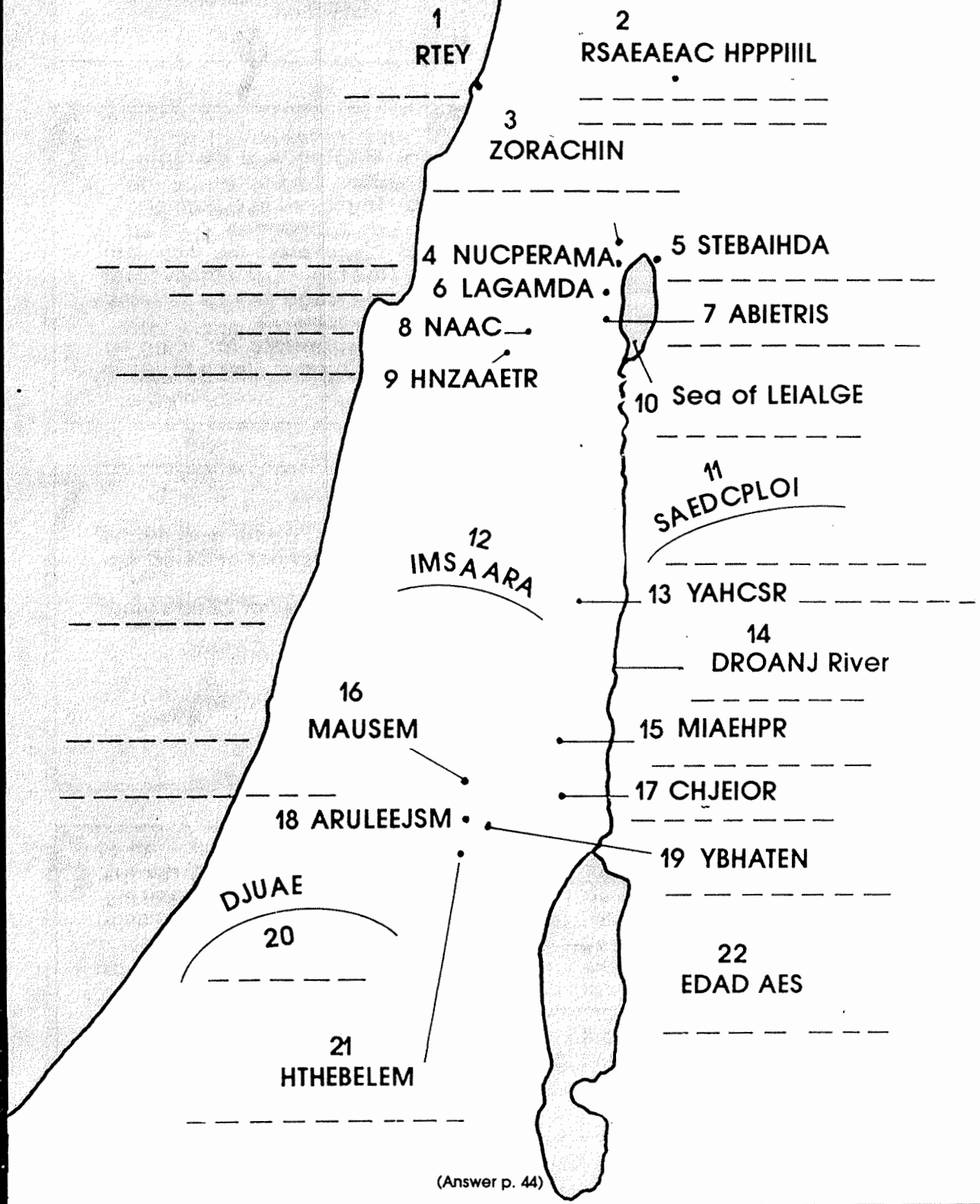
