Man Healed at Pool of Bethesda

Scriptures: John 5:1-18 and Luke 4:16-32

Key Verse: Luke 4:2 And they were astonished at his doctrine: for his word was with power.

Key Points:

- 1. Jesus went to the pool of Bethesda in Jerusalem. Here many blind and ill people would go and sit. At certain times an angel would make the waters stir and whoever reached the pool first would be healed.
- 2. There was a man who came to the pool who had been paralyzed 38 years. No one ever helped him into the pool when it was stirred. Jesus saw him lying there and healed him. He told him to take his bed and walk. This was on the Sabbath.
- 3. Jesus healing this man on the Sabbath caused quite a lot of hatred and animosity towards him from the Jews. Their interpretation of the Sabbath laws caused them to believe he should not heal on the Sabbath. They also thought the man being healed should not have picked up his bed because it was a work.
- **4.** Jesus went to Nazareth and read in the synagogue and taught the people. The crowd became so angry they intended to push Jesus off a cliff at the edge of town. Jesus miraculously escaped his presence. Everyone was amazed at Jesus.


