
Jesus Shows His Power

Scriptures: Matt 8:16-34, Luke 5:12-17, 5:1-11


Key Verse: Luke 5:5 However, the report went around concerning Him all the more; and great multitudes came together to hear, and to be healed by Him of their infirmities.


Key Points:

- 1. Jesus began to do many miracles. Each day he was quite busy. People crowded around him to hear his teachings. There were so many that houses could not contain them nor could they hear what Jesus had to say. For this reason, he went out to the side the Sea of Galilee where he taught from inside a boat. This boat belonged to Simon Peter.
- 2. After Jesus finished teaching he spoke to Simon. He and two other fishermen, James and John, had fished all night and had not caught any fish. Jesus told him to cast their nets out on the other side of the boat. So thinking it would do no good, they cast their nets as Jesus said. When they tried to pull their nets out there were so many fish caught that it almost sank the two boats they were using. They were astonished at this. Jesus told him that from now on they would be fishers of men. They left their home and became followers of Jesus.
- 3. A man had leprosy and asked Jesus to heal him and so He did. A storm arose while Jesus and his followers were in a boat on the sea. Many were afraid and Jesus asked them about their faith. He calmed the sea and many marveled. Jesus did many other miracles. People were healed and demons were cast out. At times Jesus needed a quiet place to pray. He would withdraw to a lonely place to be with His father in prayer.


