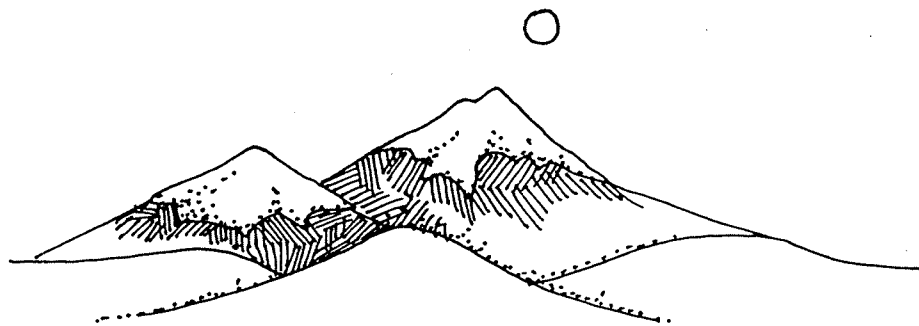
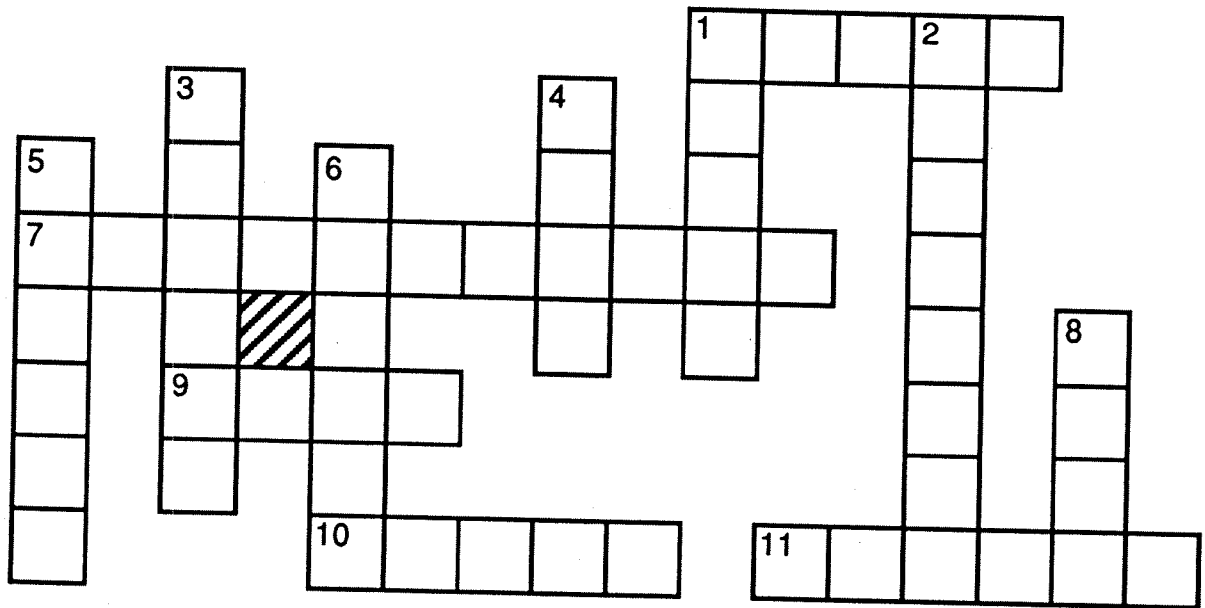

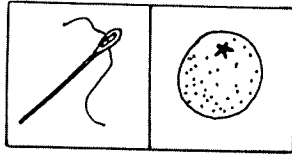
Have you memorized the Beatitudes? They are found in Matthew 5:3-11. Try doing the puzzle without looking up the passage in your Bible.

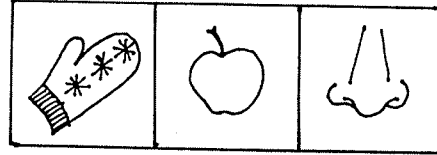
