Jesus teaches with authority




For three days Jesus taught the doctrine of love and prayer, giving comfort to all who heard "The Sermon on the Mount."


Have you memorized the Beatitudes? They are found in Matthew 5:3–11. Try doing the puzzle without looking up the passage in your Bible.
