Jesus Heals and Forgives

Scriptures: Luke 7:1-17, Luke 7:36-50, Matt 26:6-13

Key Verse: Luke 7:50 "And he said to the woman, 'Your faith has saved you, go in peace.'"

Key Points:

- 1. Jesus came to Capernaum. There was a certain centurion who had a servant who was sick and about to die. The centurion sent elders to Jesus to ask Him if He could heal his servant. The centurion felt unworthy for Jesus to come into his home and asked that Jesus just speak the words to save his servant. Jesus was amazed at the faith of this centurion. When those who were sent returned home, they found the servant healed.
- 2. Jesus went to the city of Nain. A large crowd was with him as well as his disciples. When he came close to the city, a man was being carried out in a coffin, his mother weeping beside him. He was her only son. Jesus had compassion on her and told her not to weep. Jesus touched the open coffin and told the dead man to rise up. He did and started speaking. Fear came upon those who witnessed and they glorified God. News of this quickly went throughout the region.
- 3. Jesus ate with the Pharisees. As He ate, a sinful woman came to Jesus weeping, anointing his feet with fragrant oil. She then wiped His feet with her own hair. The Pharisees and Jesus' disciples acted as though Jesus should have pushed the woman away. Yet, Jesus recognized her repentance and sorrow. He forgave her sins.
