Jesus Teaches about His Kingdom

Scriptures: Matt 13:31-52


Key Verse: Matt 13:44 "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and hid; and for joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field".

Key Points:

- 1. Jesus spoke to them in more parables. He tries to teach about the coming of His church. He wanted so much for those who would see it come or those who live now to realize it was to be a growing, nurturing institution of great value. He compared it to a mustard seed. It grows from the tiniest of seeds but when it's full grown it is as big as a tree and birds can nest in its branches.
- 2. To illustrate His point further, He teaches that the church is like yeast, which has the ability to leaven a large amount of flour until the whole amount is leavened.
- 3. Jesus again tried to show the church's value by comparing it to a treasure hidden in a field. A man wanted that treasure badly enough to sell everything he owned so that he could look for the treasure in the field. Finally he compared His church to a merchant searching for beautiful pearls. When the merchant found just one pearl of great price he sold all he had to buy it. All these illustrations teach that the church is of great value and can affect a lot of people if sought after and nurtured.
