worshiped Him, saying, "Truly You are the Son of God."


#### **Key Points:**

- 1. Jesus went out and found a large multitude that wanted to be near him. Jesus had compassion on them and healed their sick. The disciples encouraged him to send the people away to get food for themselves for it was late and they would be getting hungry. Jesus told his disciples not to send them away that they could feed them. He asked His disciples about the food they had. They only had 5 loaves and 2 fish. He had them sit on the grass in groups of 50 and 100. He blessed the food then gave it to his disciples to pass out. When it had all been passed out they had fed 5000 men and gathered 12 baskets of leftover food.
- 2. Immediately Jesus had the disciples get into a boat and go before Him to the other side of the sea, while Jesus sent the multitude away. Jesus then went to the mountain to pray. At evening, the boat was in the middle of the sea. Jesus was alone on the land.
- 3. As a great storm came up, Jesus came to them, walking on the sea. They saw him and were afraid, thinking he was ghost. Jesus told them to be of good cheer and not to be afraid. Peter wanted to walk on the water to Jesus. He started to walk out to Jesus but became afraid and began to sink. But Jesus caught him and asked him why he doubted. He calmed the sea and those on the boat were greatly amazed at Jesus and worshiped him saying "You truly are the Son of God!"






# JESUS FEEDS THE 5000




# Jesus Can Do Anything!







Jesus did many miracles that showed how much He loves and cares for people. Just as when He was on earth, Jesus has power over nature, evil spirits, sickness and death today too.


