The Transfiguration

Scriptures: Mark 9:1-10, 9:33-37

Key Verse: Mark 9:7 And a cloud came and overshadowed them; and a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is My beloved Son. Hear Him!"

Key Points:

- 1. Jesus, with Peter, James and John went up to a high mountain. His clothes became extremely white and his face was shining. He became transfigured.
- 2. Elijah appeared to them with Moses and they were talking to Jesus. This was unusual since Elijah and Moses had already died. Peter impulsively wanted to make three temples in honor of Jesus, Moses and Elijah. God spoke, acknowledging Jesus as his son.
- **3.** Suddenly they looked around and only saw Jesus. He instructed them not to tell anyone about what they had seen until he had risen from the dead. So they kept it to themselves, wondering what rising from the dead meant.
- **4.** Jesus taught and reminded them that all people who pleased God must be humble as a child and be willing to serve.
