Mary and Martha/Rich Farmer – Putting First Things First

Scriptures: Luke 10:38-42, 12:13-41

Key Verse: Luke 12:31: "But seek the kingdom of God, and all these things shall be added unto you."

Key Points:

- 1. As Jesus was traveling, He entered the home of Martha and Mary. Mary sat at the feet of the Savior and listened to His teaching, while Martha was busy with much serving and preparations.
- 2. When Martha asked Jesus to tell Mary to help her with the chores, Jesus answered her that while Martha was full of care for many things, Mary had chosen the one thing that was needful, and she must not be scolded for that.
- **3.** While Jesus was teaching to the multitudes, people began to question him concerning matters of money. Jesus told them to take care not to become too worried about money.
- **4.** Jesus tells the story of the rich farmer, who when he had an abundant harvest, thought to tear down his barns and build bigger barns to store the fruits of his labor in. He congratulated himself and decided to eat, drink, and be merry.
- 5. However, God called him a fool, and told him that his soul would be required of him for not giving God the glory for his success.
- **6**. Jesus preaches about many money matters to the multitudes, teaching them to not worry about material things, for God will care for His own, and to be good stewards of the things that God has given to us. He finishes His teachings by telling the multitudes to be prepared, for no one knows the day or the hour that the Lord will return.






