
### The Prodigal Son

Scriptures: Luke 15:11-32

Key Verse: Luke 15:32: "It is right that we should make merry and be glad, for your brother was dead and is alive again, was lost and is found."

### **Key Points:**

- 1. Jesus spoke again to His followers in a parable, telling the story of a man who had two sons. The younger son asked for his share of his inheritance and, when he had received it, traveled to a far away county and spent all his money in wasteful living.
- 2. When he was all out of money, there was a famine in the land, and the son went to work for a man, feeding his swine. The son was so hungry, he wished to eat the food that was fed to the pigs.
- 3. When he came to himself, he thought to himself that the servants in his father's house were better off than he was, and that he would go to his father and beg forgiveness, and ask to work for him. So he began to travel towards home.
- 4. And while he was still a long way off, his father saw him, and rejoiced, and ran to meet him. After the son had asked his forgiveness, the father dressed him in a robe, put a ring on his finger, and shoes on his feet, and had a great feast prepared for him.
- 5. When the older son learned of all the festivities, he was angry and refused to come in. His father explained to him that what was lost had been found.



He went back to his father and said, "I'm sorry."


The father was happy that his son came back because he loved his son very much.






