
#### The Rich Man and Lazarus

Scriptures: Luke 16:19-31


Key Verse: John 14:2: "In my Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you so. I go to prepare a place for you."


#### **Key Points:**

- 1. There was a rich man who lived luxuriously, and a beggar named Lazarus who lived at his gates, longing for the crumbs from the rich man's table while the dogs licked at his sores.
- 2. Lazarus died and was carried to Abraham's bosom. The rich man also died. He could see Lazarus from his place in torments.
- **3**. The rich man asks Abraham to send Lazarus to drop cool water on his tongue.
- **4.** When Abraham tells him that there is a great gulf between them and it is impossible, the rich man asks Abraham to send Lazarus to his brothers to serve God.
- **5.** Abraham also denies this request, telling the rich man that his brothers have the law and the prophets and they should believe them.










