## Lazarus is Raised from the Dead

Scriptures: John 11:1-46

Key Verse: John 11:35: "Jesus wept."

## **Key Points:**

- 1. Mary and Martha, the sisters of Lazarus, sent word to Jesus that Lazarus was very sick. Jesus waited two days after he received the news to travel to Judea.
- 2. Jesus told His followers that Lazarus had fallen asleep, and they assumed He meant he had actually fallen asleep and Jesus was going to wake him up. Jesus explains to them that Lazarus is dead, and that He was glad they were not there, so they could believe.
- 3. When they arrived, Lazarus had been in the grave four days. Martha ran out to meet Jesus, and she told Him that she believed if Jesus had been there, her brother would not have died, but that Jesus had the power to ask God and receive resurrection for Lazarus. Jesus commends her on her faith.
- **4.** Jesus arrived at their home, and found Mary weeping there. Jesus weeps with her, and then asks to be taken to the grave.
- **5.** At the grave, Jesus commands Martha to move the stone aside. He prays to God, then in a loud voice, Jesus commands Lazarus to come forth.
- **6.** Lazarus comes out of the grave, bound hand and foot. Jesus directs them to loose Lazarus, and many Jews believed on Jesus.
