Week 137 A Widow, Wise and Foolish Virgins, and Wise and Foolish Servants

Scriptures: Luke 21:1-4, Matt 25:1-30

Key Verse: Matt 25:23: "And his lord said unto him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant, you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter thou into the joy of your Lord."

Key Points:

- 1. Jesus saw a widow in the temple putting her two mites into the offering, after all of the rich men bestowing all their gifts. Jesus told those around him that the widow had given much more than all of the others, because she gave all that she had.
- **2.** Jesus also told a parable, comparing the kingdom of heaven to ten virgins, who took their lamps to go meet the bridegroom. Five were wise, and five were foolish.
- 3. The five foolish virgins ran out of oil when the bridegroom was coming, and asked the five wise virgins to give them oil. The five wise virgins refused, and told them to go buy some for themselves. While the five foolish virgins were gone, the bridegroom came, and they were shut out.
- **4.** Jesus spoke again and said the kingdom of heaven was like a man who, when he was traveling to a far country, divided his goods among his three servants. He gave one five talents, one two talents, and to one servant he gave one talent, according to their abilities.
- 5. The servants that had five and two talents went and traded them, and doubled what they had before. The servant with one talent went and buried it until the master returned. When he returned, he complimented the first two servants on their faithfulness.
- **6.** The master scolded the last servant, calling him lazy and wicked. He took the one talent from him and gave it to the one that had ten talents. The wicked servant was cast out to the outer darkness.
