
### The Death and Burial of Jesus

Scriptures: Matt 27:39-66, Luke 23:34-56

Key Verse: Matt 27:54 "So when the centurion and those with him, who were guarding Jesus, saw the earthquake and the things that had happened, they feared greatly, saying, 'Truly, this was the Son of God!'"


### **Key Points:**

- 1. One of the criminals next to Jesus mocked Him, saying, "If you are Christ, save yourself and us." The other criminal rebuked the first, saying that they were guilty and deserved crucifixion, but Jesus was innocent. He asked Jesus to remember him in the heavenly kingdom. Jesus promised the thief that he would be with Him in Paradise.
- 2. It was very dark during the crucifixion. About the ninth hour (3 pm), Jesus cried, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" Someone offered Jesus sour wine to drink. Jesus cried out "Father, into your hands, I commit my spirit" and He died. Immediately there was an earthquake, the veil in the temple was torn, graves were opened. Many women who had followed Jesus were there, watching from a distance.
- 3. Joseph, a rich man from Arimathea, asked Pilate for the body of Jesus. He wrapped the body in a linen cloth and laid it in a new tomb. The women followed and saw the tomb. They returned to their places and prepared spices and oils.
- 4. Meanwhile, Pilate sent guards, and the priests and Pharisees sealed the tomb to make it secure.






They wanted him to save himself, but he couldn't. He was caught and crucified, as he said he would be.

For these things were done, that the scripture should be fulfilled, A bone of him shall not be broken. And again another scripture saith, They shall look on him whom they pierced.






