### The Day of Pentecost

Scriptures: Acts 1:15-26, Acts 2

Key Verse: Acts 2:38 "Then Peter said to them, 'Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.'"

### **Key Points:**

- 1. Peter and the other disciples chose Matthias to take Judas' place as an apostle. The disciples numbered 120.
- 2. They were gathered together on the Day of Pentecost. The sound of a rushing wind came from heaven, and a divided tongue of fire sat upon each of them.
- 3. They were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in tongues.
- **4.** Jews from every nation heard the disciples speak in their own language, and they wondered what this could mean. But some men mocked the disciples, saying they were drunk.
- **5.** Peter stood and delivered a sermon, explaining how Jesus fulfilled prophesies in the scriptures. Although Jesus was crucified and died, God raised Him up, and He is Lord and Christ.
- **6.** The people were cut to the heart, and said "What shall we do?" They were told to repent and be baptized to receive the gift of the Holy Sprit. About three thousand souls were added to the church.
- 7. They followed the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, breaking the bread, and prayer. They divided their possessions so that no one was in need. And more souls were added to the church each day.





Fifty days after Jesus' death, and after his ascension, was the day of the Pentecost. There was a great noise and tongues of fire became visible.







### For the Teacher
