#### A Lame Man Healed--Ananias and Sapphira

**Scriptures:** Acts 3:1-11, Acts 5:1-11

Key Verse: Acts 5:4 "... 'Why have you conceived this thing in your

heart? You have not lied to men but to God.""

#### **Key Points:**

- 1. Peter and John went to the temple to pray. They saw a lame man by the gate who asked them for money. Peter said "I do not have silver or gold, but what I do have I give you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk." Peter took his hand and lifted the man, and his legs became strong.
- 2. The man entered the temple with Peter and John, leaping, walking and praising God. The people who saw them were amazed because they knew this was the man who sat begging for charity.
- **3.** A man named Ananias and his wife, Sapphira, sold some property. With his wife's knowledge, Ananias brought a portion of the money from the sale to the apostles. He wanted people to think that he was giving all the money they made from the sale.
- **4.** Peter told him that the land and the money were his to control, but he could not lie to God. Ananias fell dead at his feet. The young men carried him out and buried him.
- 5. Three hours later, Sapphira came in, not knowing what had happened to her husband. Peter asked if she had sold the land for the price Ananias had said. She answered yes. Peter said, "How is it that you have agreed together to test the Spirit of the Lord? Look, the feet of those who have buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out."
- **6**. Immediately, she fell dead and was buried near her husband.
- 7. The people in the church and all others who heard what had happened were very fearful.




