### **Paul's Second Journey**

**Scriptures: Acts 15:30-41 and 16**

**Key Verse: Acts 16:31** So they said, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household."

#### **Key Points:**

1. After returning to Antioch and preaching there awhile, Paul desired to go back and encourage the churches they had founded on their first journey. Barnabas was determined to take John Mark but Paul refused because he had left them on their first journey to return to Jerusalem. They argued quite severely over this so that they left one another. Paul chose Silas to go with him and Barnabas took John Mark. They went throughout Syria and Cilicia, strengthening the churches.
2. In Lystra and Derbe Paul and Silas met Timothy. He was a young man well spoken of by the brethren. He went with them on their journey.
3. In Philippi, they went to the river to pray. They sat down with women who were meeting there. A woman named Lydia heard them and she opened her heart to the Word of the Lord. She and her household here baptized. Paul and Silas went to her home and stayed for awhile.
4. A young slave girl was possessed with an evil spirit. Her masters made money from her fortune telling. She followed Paul, crying out things about God to them. This annoyed Paul and he commanded the spirit to come out. The masters were angry about this and brought Paul and Silas before the magistrates, telling lies about them. A multitude rose up against them, tore off their clothes and beat them with rods. They then threw them into jail.
5. Paul and Silas were singing about midnight and the prisoners were listening. There was a great earthquake and the door of the jail opened and the prisoners' chains were loosed. The jailer came awake from his sleep thinking all the prisoners had fled. Then, he drew his sword to kill himself. Paul with a loud voice, told him to do no harm to himself, that they were all there. The jailer ran in and asked what he must do to be saved. They spoke the Word of the Lord to him and he and his house were baptized.

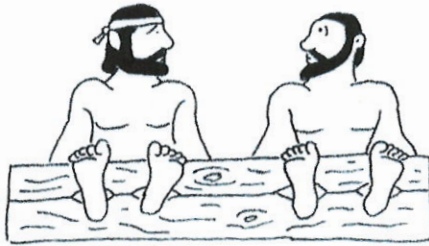






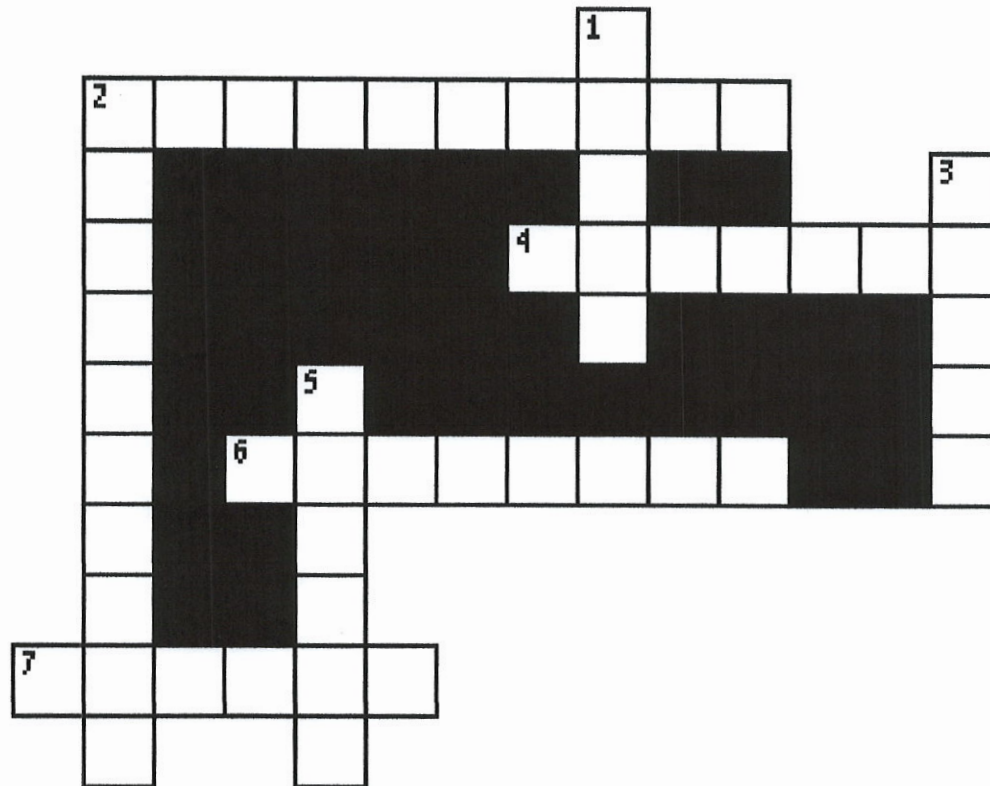


Help Paul and Silas get out of the stocks and go through the maze to where the jailer is being baptized.

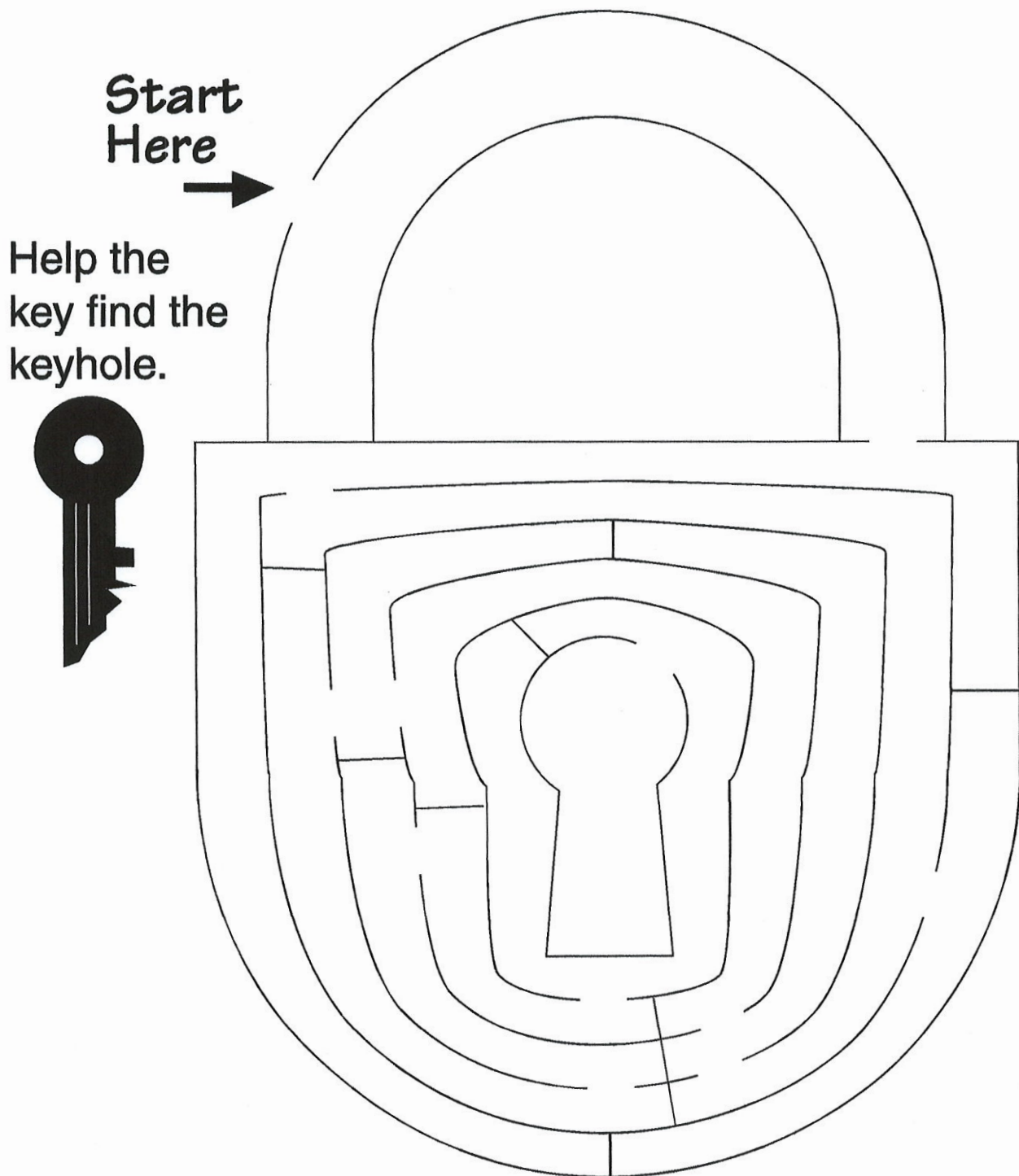

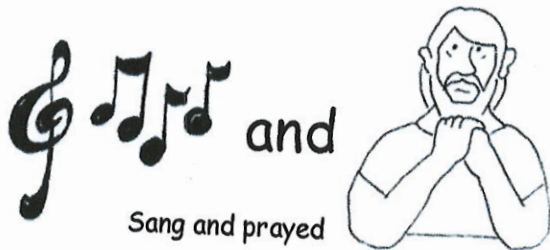




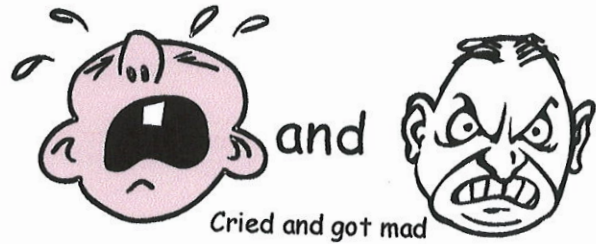
Paul and Silas did not need a key to open the prison doors. God caused an earthquake to open the doors and to make the chains fall away.

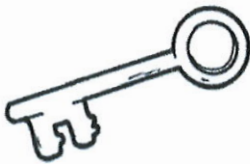
