Key Verse:


Genesis 2:7 And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being.

Key Points:

- 1. God made man of the dust of the ground. He made him in His image.
- **2.** God made a beautiful garden for man to live in and planted it with everything he needed.
- 3. Adam was to keep and tend the garden.
- 4. God told Adam not to eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. This was the first commandment of God to man. If Adam disobeyed he could die.
- 5. God brought the animals to Adam for Adam to name.
- **6**. God made a helper for Adam, and gave him Eve as his wife.




God Makes People Genesis 1, 2






In the beautiful garden God made for Adam and Eve, He put trees with delicious fruit growing on them.





GARDEN OF EDEN DIRT SOUFFLÉ



"Then the Lord God planted a garden in the east, in a place called Eden" (Genesis 2:8a).

More fun than mud pies! Kids will delight in customizing their own mini-gardens.


- 1. Form groups of four to six. Give each group a quart jar with a lid, pudding mix, two cups of milk, chocolate sandwich cookies in a strong resealable plastic bag, a rolling pin, plastic spoons, and a clay pot. Set the animal crackers, gummy worms, and jelly beans on a table where all the groups will have access to them.
- 2. Have each group choose people to be Pudding Shakers and Cookie Crushers. Instruct the Pudding Shakers to pour the milk and pudding mix into the quart jar, tightly screw on the lid, and shake the jars for three minutes.
- 3. Meanwhile, have the Cookie Crushers roll the rolling pins over the sealed bags to make cookie-crumb "dirt."
- 4. When the pudding is made and the cookies are crushed, gather kids and do the Faith Booster below.
- 5. Invite each group to create a "Garden of Eden" in their clay pot. Let them layer the pudding and cookie dirt, help themselves to crackers and worms, and use the jelly beans as flowers.
- 6. When the gardens are complete, let kids admire each other's work. Then let each child "dig in" to the gardens, scoop a generous helping into a paper cup, and gobble!

FAITH BOOSTER

Ask:

- What do you know about the Garden of Eden? Read aloud Genesis 2:4-9. Ask:
- What do you think it would have been like to live in that garden?
- What's the most beautiful garden you've ever seen?

Let volunteers tell why Adam and Eve had to leave the garden. Explain that many people have looked for the Garden of Eden, but no one knows exactly where it was. Tell kids we can imagine what the Garden of Eden was like and we'll have some creative fun making Garden of Eden Dirt Soufflés.

WHAT TO DO

- 1. Introduce the lesson by telling the story found in Genesis 2:20-24 and 4:1-2. Say, God made a man and called him "Adam." He made a woman who was named Eve. Then Adam and Eve had a son named Cain and another son named Abel. They were the very first family in the world. God makes families.
- 2. Show the children the sample.
- 3. Distribute a pattern page to each child.
- 4. Say the memory verse.
- 5. Have the children fold the page on the broken lines and color the pictures on the flaps. Say, Adam and Eve were the first people God made. They had two sons. They were the first family.
- 6. Have the children open the flaps and draw a picture of their own families inside.
- 7. When the pictures are finished, have the children show the pictures of their families. Practice the memory verse together. Ask, Can you point to Adam and Eve? Where are their sons? This is the first family God made.



Provide magazine cut-outs of families. Have the children glue one or more of the cut-outs inside the folding picture.






