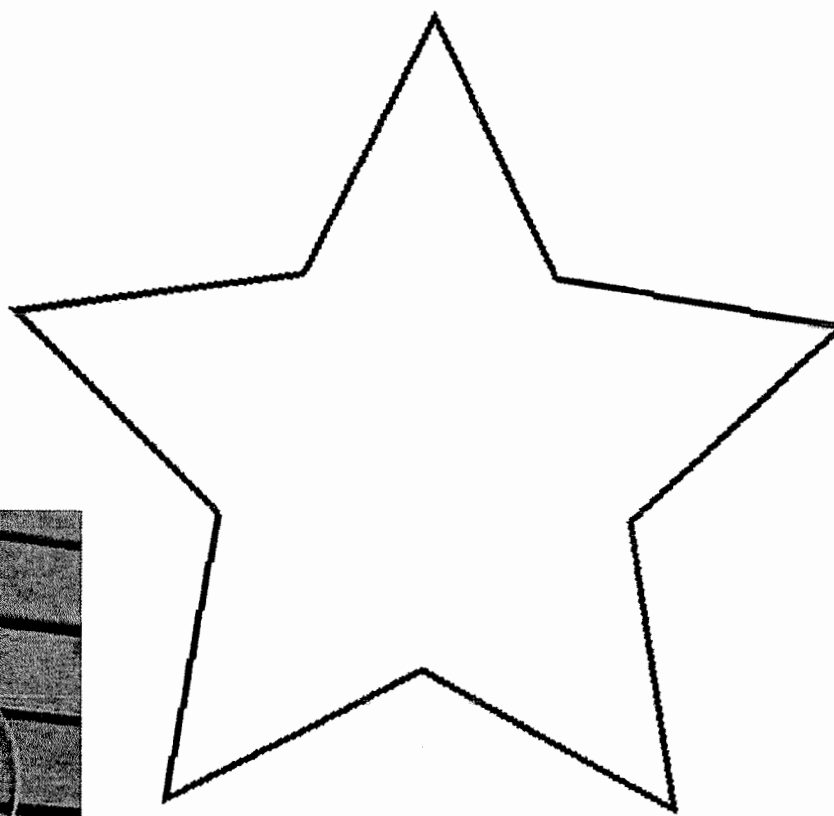
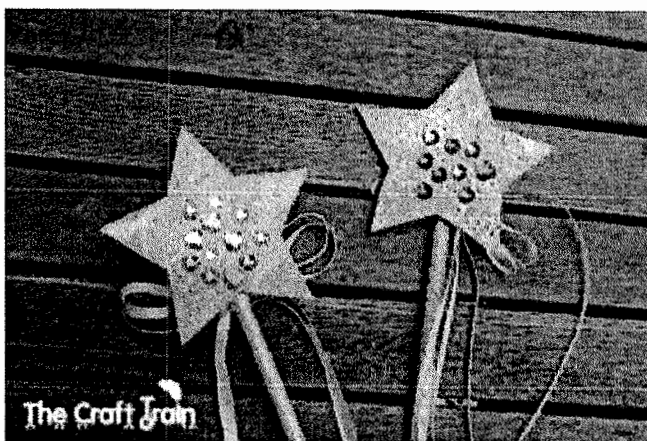
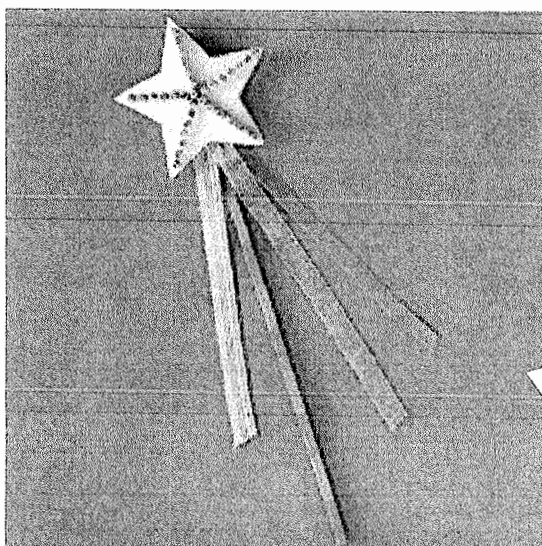
1. Print out template on craft paper

Star Garland (Toddlers)

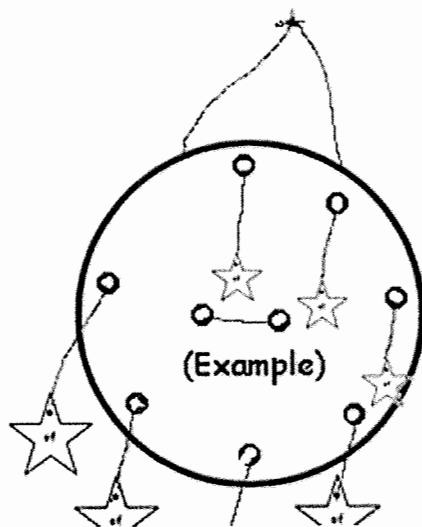
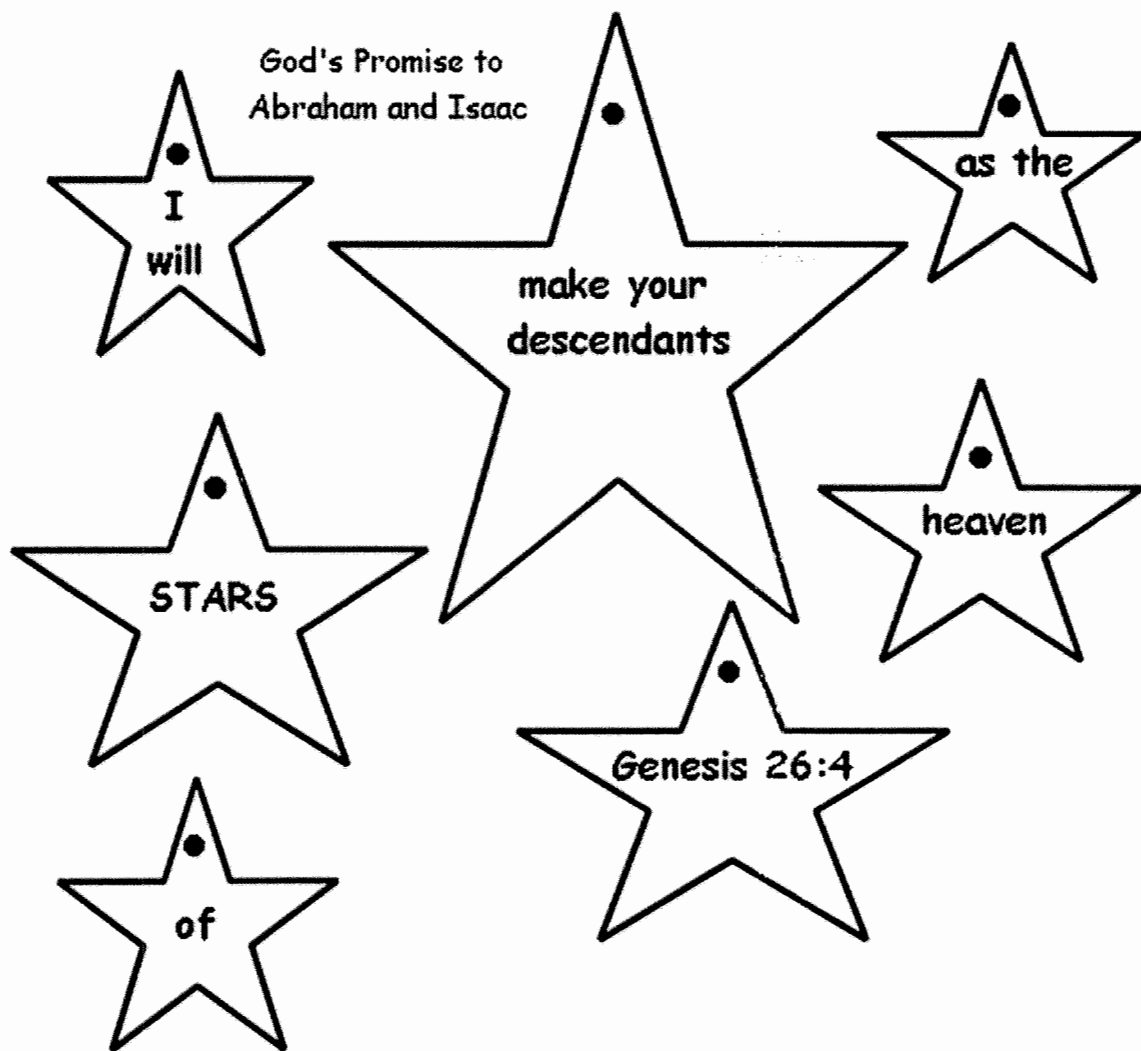
- Cut several stars out of card stock.

Attach string to the stars.

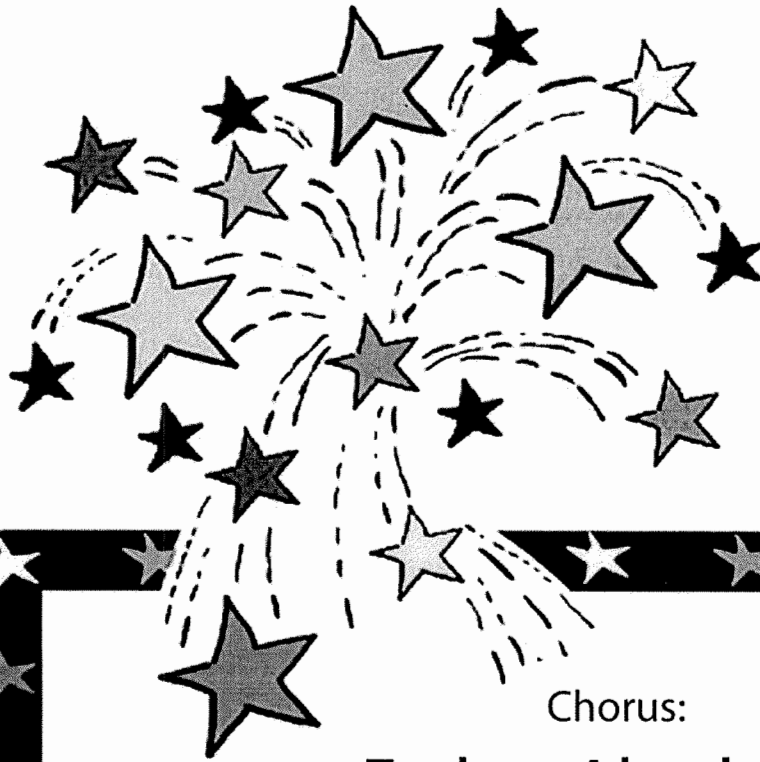
Attach other end of string to a paper plate.
