Scriptures: Genesis 24

Key Verse: Gen. 24:67 Isaac brought her into the tent of his mother Sarah, and he married Rebekah. So she became his wife, and he loved her.

Key Points:

1. Abraham wanted Isaac to have a wife who also loved God.
2. Abraham's servant prayed for a sign to find the right woman. He met Rebekah at the well, and the sign was fulfilled that she would also give the camels a drink.
3. Rebekah was willing to leave her home to serve God. She left with her family's blessing because they recognized that this was from God.
4. Isaac loved Rebekah, and was comforted after his mother's death.





Follow the Path to Find Rebekah


Abraham knew his son Isaac needed a wife. He sent his servant to find a girl to marry Isaac. Follow the path to see what happened. Then color the pictures.
