Scriptures: Genesis 27

Key Verse: Gen. 27:38 And Esau said to his father, "Have you only one blessing? Bless me—me also, Oh my father"

Key Points:

1. Isaac was old and he wanted to bless Esau before he died.
2. Rebekah and Jacob tricked Isaac into giving Jacob the blessing that should have been Esau's.
3. Esau was very angry and planned to kill Jacob after their father died.
4. Rebekah and Isaac sent Jacob to his uncle Laban to save him from Esau and to find a wife.

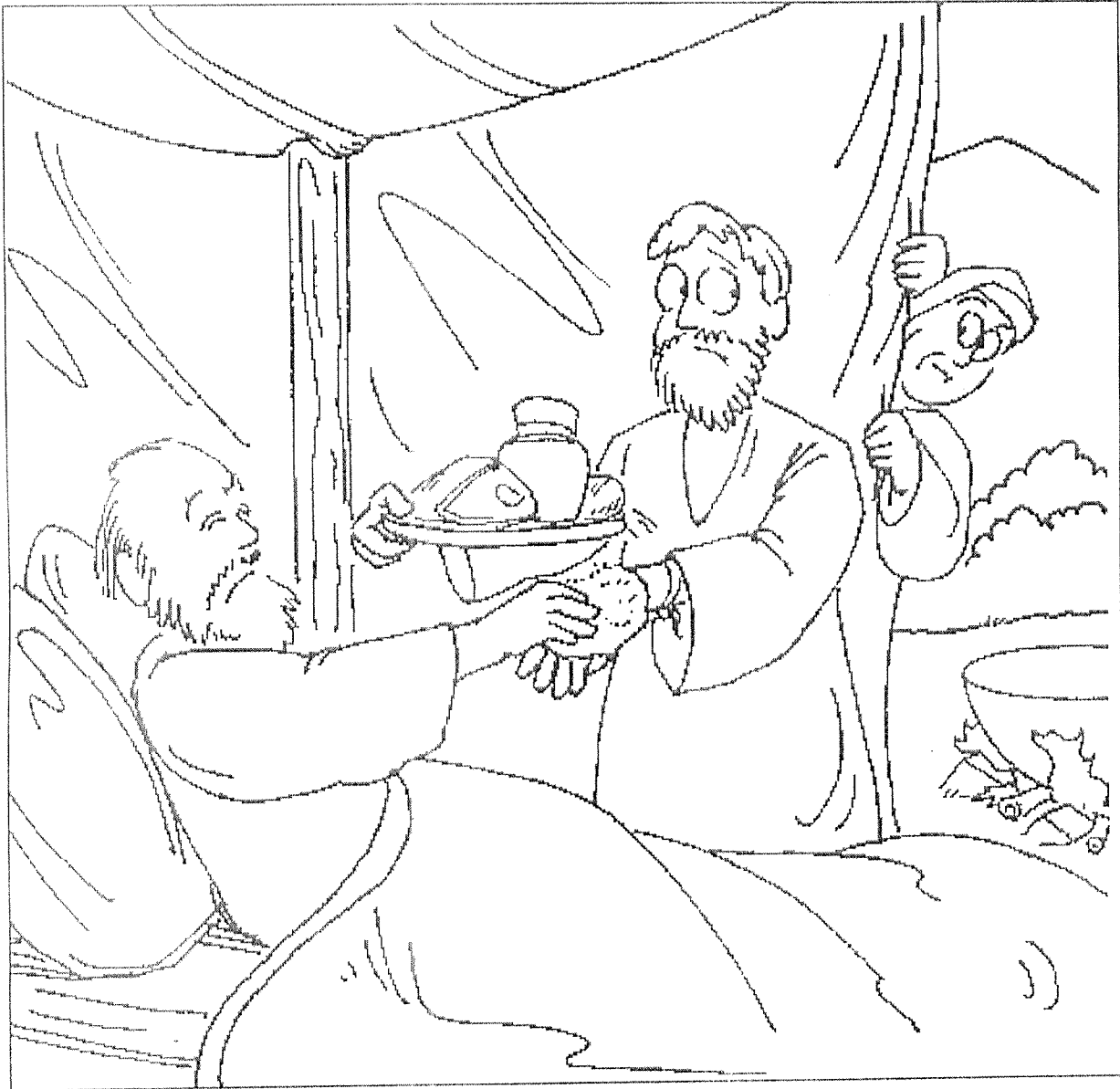
Then Jacob gave Esau bread and pottage of lentiles;

way: thus Esau despised his birthright.

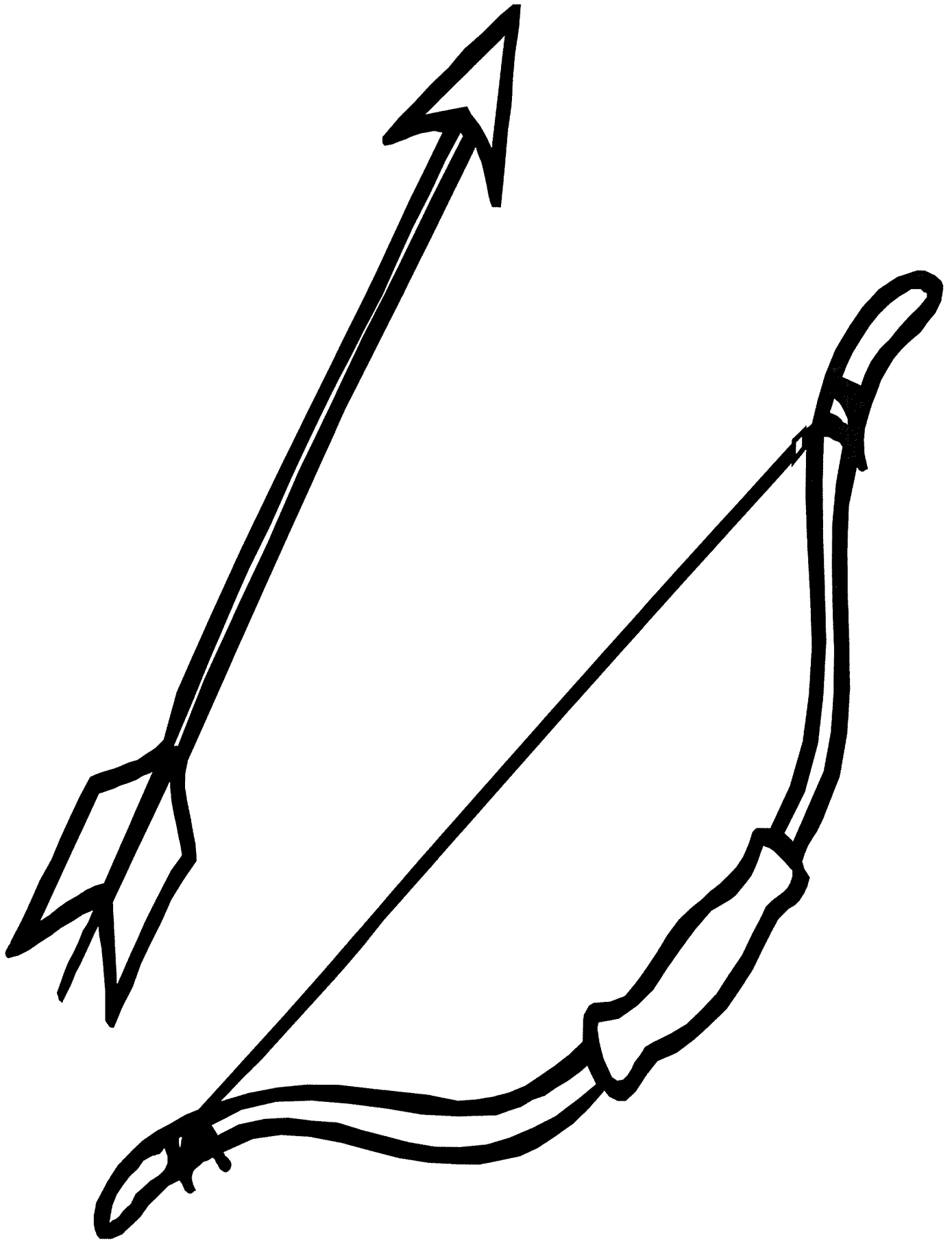
