Jacob Wrestles with an Angel and Receives a New Name

Scriptures: Genesis 32 & 33

Key Verse: Genesis 32:28 "And He said, 'Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel; for you have struggled with God and with men, and have prevailed."


Key Points:

- 1. On his journey home, Jacob approached Esau's home. Jacob's messengers told him that Esau was on his way to meet his brother with 400 men. He was afraid Esau would be angry and would want to harm him and his family.
- 2. Jacob prayed to God that his brother Esau would not harm him or his family.
- **3.** In the night Jacob was left alone, and an angel came and wrestled with him all night. The angel touched the socket of Jacob's hip, and it came out of joint. The angel asked Jacob his name and told him he would no longer be called Jacob but Israel, for he had struggled with God and with man and had prevailed.
- 4. Esau and Jacob reconcile.



Before Jacob reached Canaan, he wrestled with an angel of God. Because Jacob's spirit did not fail, God named him Israel, which means "The Reliable One."

Then the angel said:

"Your name shall no more be called Ja'cob, but Is ra-el, that is, 'He who wrestles with God.' For you have wrestled with God and have won the vicrory."
