Key Verse:


Gen. 4:9 "Then the LORD said to Cain, Where is Abel thy brother? And he said, I know not: am I my brother's keeper?"

Key Points:

- **1.** Adam and Eve had two sons-Cain and Abel. Abel was a shepherd; Cain tilled the ground.
- 2. By faith, Abel brought sheep to sacrifice to God, but Cain brought offerings from his crops. God respected Abel's offering. Cain became very angry.
- 3. God asked Cain why he was angry, and encouraged him to do the right thing and not sin. Cain made the wrong choice and killed Abel.
- **4**. God punished Cain, but put a mark on Cain to protect him from others.







Cain and Abel Crossword




