Joseph's Brothers Visit Egypt

Scriptures: Genesis 42

Key Verse: Genesis 42:6 Now Joseph was governor over the land; and it was he who sold grain to all the people of the land. And Joseph's brothers came and bowed down before him with their faces to the earth.

Key Points:

- 1. The famine was great in the land so Jacob sends his sons to Egypt to buy grain, Benjamin did not go.
- 2. Joseph was governor of the land so the brothers had to go to him to buy their grain. They bowed down before him, just as was as prophesied in Joseph's dreams.
- 3. Joseph recognized his brothers, but they did not recognize him. He accused them of being spies and put them in prison 3 days. On the third day, in order to prove they were not spies, Joseph made them go back to their father and bring Benjamin to Egypt when they returned. Simeon had to remain there in prison.
- 4. Joseph had their sacks filled with grain, also returning their money in their sacks as well. On their journey home, the brothers discovered the money and were fearful of what that might mean.
- 5. They returned to their father and told him all that had happened. Jacob grieved that Joseph was dead, Simeon was in prison and now they wanted to take Benjamin. Jacob said that they would not return to Egypt, however, their grain did run out.


Construction paper—gray or brown, and contrasting color Cardboard or tagboard

Cardboard or tagboard
Popcorn (unpopped)
Felt-tip pen—black
Silver crayon or foil
Chenille Wire
Yarn
Glue


Directions:

Using donkey pattern (page 23), cut two donkeys out of gray or brown construction paper. Draw details with black felt-tip pen. Glue figures together, inserting one 3-inch piece of chenille wire in front and one piece in back legs. Leave 1-inch ends of wire below feet. Cut two bases, 31/2 inches by 21/2 inches. Punch holes to match with feet and insert chenille wire ends in holes, bending wires in opposite directions. Glue other base on bottom, over exposed wires. Cut two saddlebags from contrasting shade of paper. Fold and glue on sides, inserting small pieces of varn in seams to connect bags. Place saddlebags over donkey's back and add glue beneath yarn. Cut coins from cardboard or tagboard and color with silver crayon, or cover with foil. Put corn and coins in saddlebags. Cut 6 inches of yarn and tie ends together. Cut a slit for donkey's mouth and insert yarn rein.

These questions can also be used with the many Bible drills and quizzes in this book.

Joseph Quiz Questions:

- 1. Who was Jacob's favorite son? Joseph.
- 2. Why was he the favorite of Jacob? He was the son of Jacob's old age.
- 3. Who was Joseph's grandfather? Isaac. Who was his great-grandfather? Abraham.
- 4. How many brothers did Joseph have? How many sisters? 11 brothers and one sister.
- 5. Why were his brothers jealous of Joseph? They disliked the favor their father paid him.
- 6. What was the main idea of Joseph's dream? That someday Joseph's brothers would bow down to him.

- 16. What did Joseph tell Pharaoh he must do after Joseph interpreted the dreams? He must store up food for seven years until the years of famine. If he did this there would be enough food.
- 17. Who did Pharaoh set up as the leader in collecting the grain? Joseph.
- 18. Who came to buy food in Egypt? Joseph's brothers.
- 19. What did Joseph do when he recognized them, but they did not recognize him? At first he treated them harshly, and at last he told them who he was.
- 20. What did Joseph insist his brothers do? Bring Benjamin to Egypt.
- 21. Did Joseph ever see his father again? Yes, he was finally reunited with him and Isaac lived to see Joseph's sons.
