#### Joseph Reveals Himself

Scriptures: Genesis 44 – 45:15

Key Verse: Genesis 44:7 And God sent me before you to preserve a posterity for you in the earth, and to save your lives by a great deliverance.

#### **Key Points:**

- 1. Joseph had his brothers sacks filled with grain again, also putting their money back. Joseph also instructed that his silver cup be put in Benjamin's sack.
- 2. As the brothers journeyed back home, Joseph sent his messenger to catch up to them and confront them about the money and cup.
- 3. Because of the cup being found in Benjamin's sack, he was to come back to Joseph and be his slave. In their grief, they tore they clothes and returned to face Joseph. Once again they fell on the ground before him.
- 4. Judah intercedes for Benjamin, explaining how grieved their father will be, also offering to be his slave in Benjamin's place. This is an interesting change of events, since it was Judah, who 22 years earlier, wanted to sell Joseph to the Ishmaelites. Judah had become a better man, willing now to offer his own life for Benjamin.
- 5. Joseph can no longer restrain himself and reveals his identity. He told them not to fear him or be angry at themselves because it was God's plan that he go to Egypt to preserve their lives and the lives of others.
- 6. Joseph tells them to bring their father to Egypt where he could provide for them for there would be 5 more years of famine. Joseph was filled with emotion and wept with his brothers.







A servant put Joseph's silver cup in Benjamin's sack of grain. Joseph sent the servant to make the brothers return.

Because of the famine in Canaan, Jacob sent his sons to Egypt for grain. There they met their brother, Joseph.








