### God Calls Moses through a Burning Bush

Scriptures: Exodus 3 and 4

Key Verse: Exodus 3:5 Then He said "Do not draw near this place. Take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground."


### **Key Points:**


- 1. Moses led Jethro's flock into the desert and came to Mt. Horeb, the mountain of God. The Angel of the Lord appears from a bush that was burning with fire. God calls to him by name as Moses turned to look where the fire was coming from. He tells Moses to take off his sandals for he was standing on holy ground. Moses hid his face as he heard the voice of God for he was afraid to look upon God.
- 2. God tells Moses that he has heard the cries of his people and has come to deliver them out of the land of Egypt. He wants to use Moses as his representative to go to Pharaoh. Moses felt unable to do the job God wanted him to do. God tells him that he will be with him, that he should say that, "I AM" has sent him. This is the Hebrew name YHWH (Jehovah) translated here as "I AM".
- 3. Moses is to go to Pharaoh with the elders of Israel and tell him to let His people go. Moses worries he is slow of speech and cannot talk to Pharaoh. God gave Moses mighty deeds to show Pharaoh; a rod turns into a snake, a hand becoming leprous, water turnd to blood. He warns Moses to use all the deeds he has given him. Aaron is sent with him to help Moses speak.
- 4. God tells Moses he will harden Pharaoh's heart so that he will by no means let the people go. The elders of Israel will see all the signs Moses does and bow their heads to worship the Lord. It was hard for Moses, but he trusted that God would provide the power to do what was asked.





Moses became a shepherd in Midian. One day, God spoke to him from a burning bush. God told Moses to go back to Egypt to help his people.




# What to Do


- **1.** Give each child a pattern page.
- **2.** Tell the story of Moses and the burning bush, from Exodus 3.
- **3.** Say, God called to Moses to remove his sandals. When we approach God, we should remember that it is a privilege to talk to and hear from God. Our "Barefoot Before God" plaques will remind us that God calls each of us to serve Him.
- **4.** Have each student cut the oval from the pattern page and glue it to a 9" x 12" piece of felt.
- **5.** Show how to fold over 1" of the top of the felt toward the back, and glue or staple it to secure.
- **6.** Have each child thread a chenille stem through the opening of the folded felt, and bend down the ends.
- **7.** Show how to tie each end of a two-foot length of yarn to either end of the chenille stem to form a hanger.
- **8.** Have each child make a fist, then press the end of the fist into the paint and onto the plaque. Show how to put small fingerprints above the print for toes. Repeat for the other "foot."
