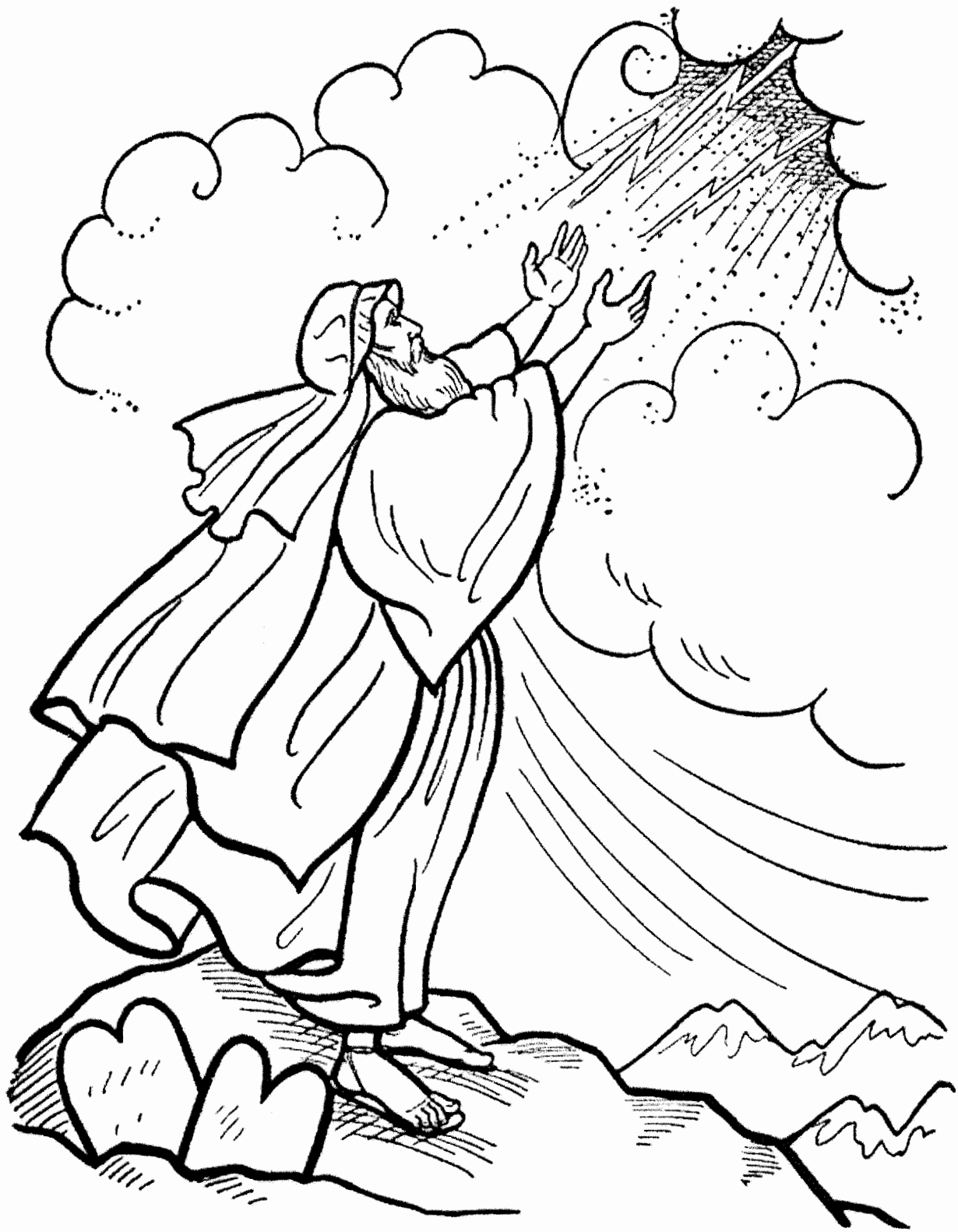
### **Moses Receives the Law**

**Scriptures: Exodus 20 and 32**

**Key Verse: Exodus 32:26 Then Moses said, “Whoever is on the Lord’s side—come to me!”**

#### **Key Points:**

1. God wrote the Ten Commandments on two tablets of stone, and gave them to Moses on Mt. Sinai.
2. While Moses was receiving the commandments from God, the people became restless.
3. Aaron asked the people for their gold jewelry and formed it into an idol of a golden calf.
4. God had told the Israelites to serve Him only. Moses begged God to be patient with the people, and God showed mercy to them.
5. God sent Moses back, but Moses was so angry he broke the stone tablets. Then he ground the golden calf into dust, put the dust in the water and had the people drink it.
6. Those who did not repent were killed.



God called Moses to the top of Mt. Sinai and gave him  
the ten commandments.



Moses went to the top of Mt. Sinai to talk with God. God gave Moses His Ten Commandments written on tables of stone. These were the laws God wanted His people to obey.

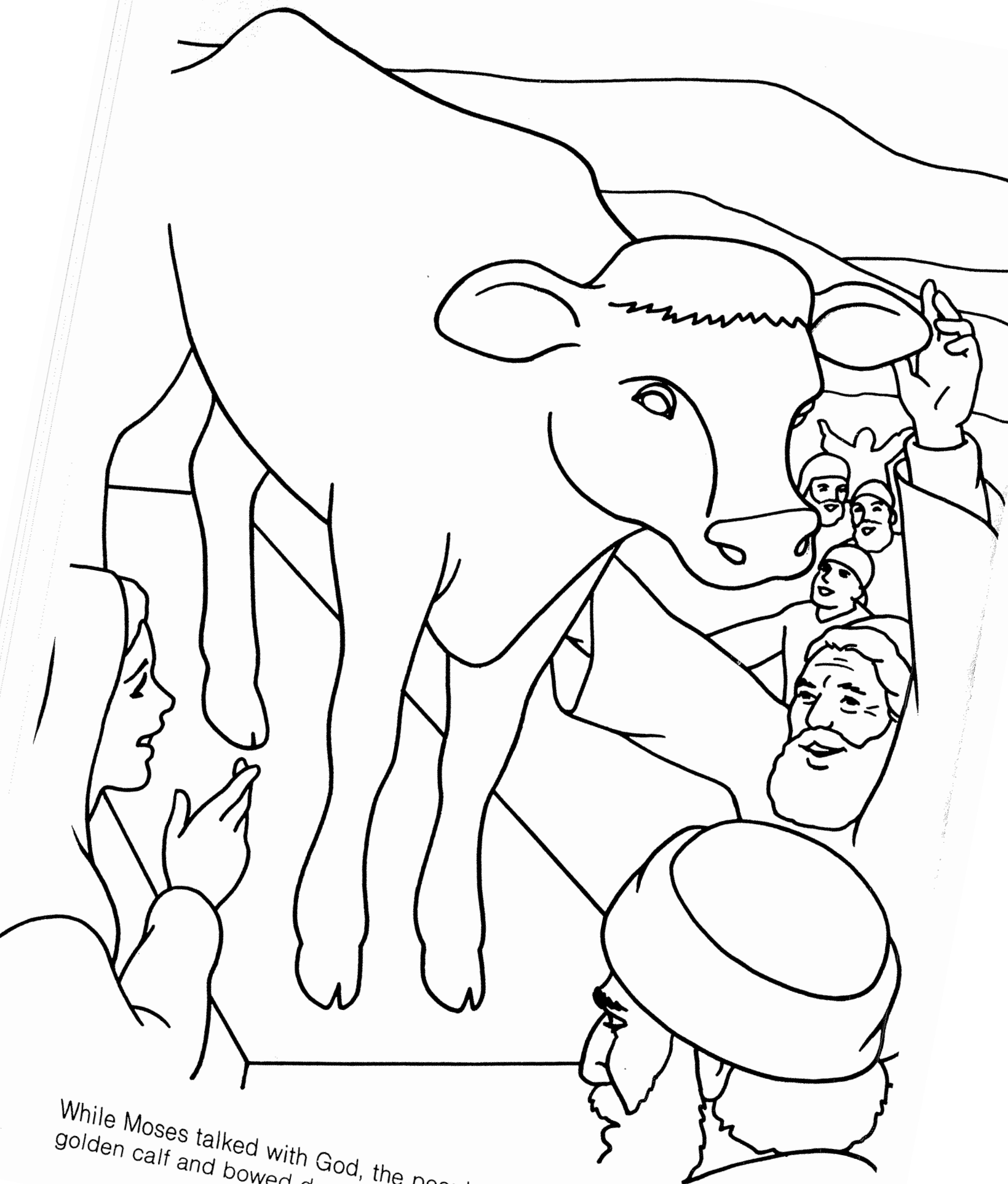

# Worshipping the Golden Calf

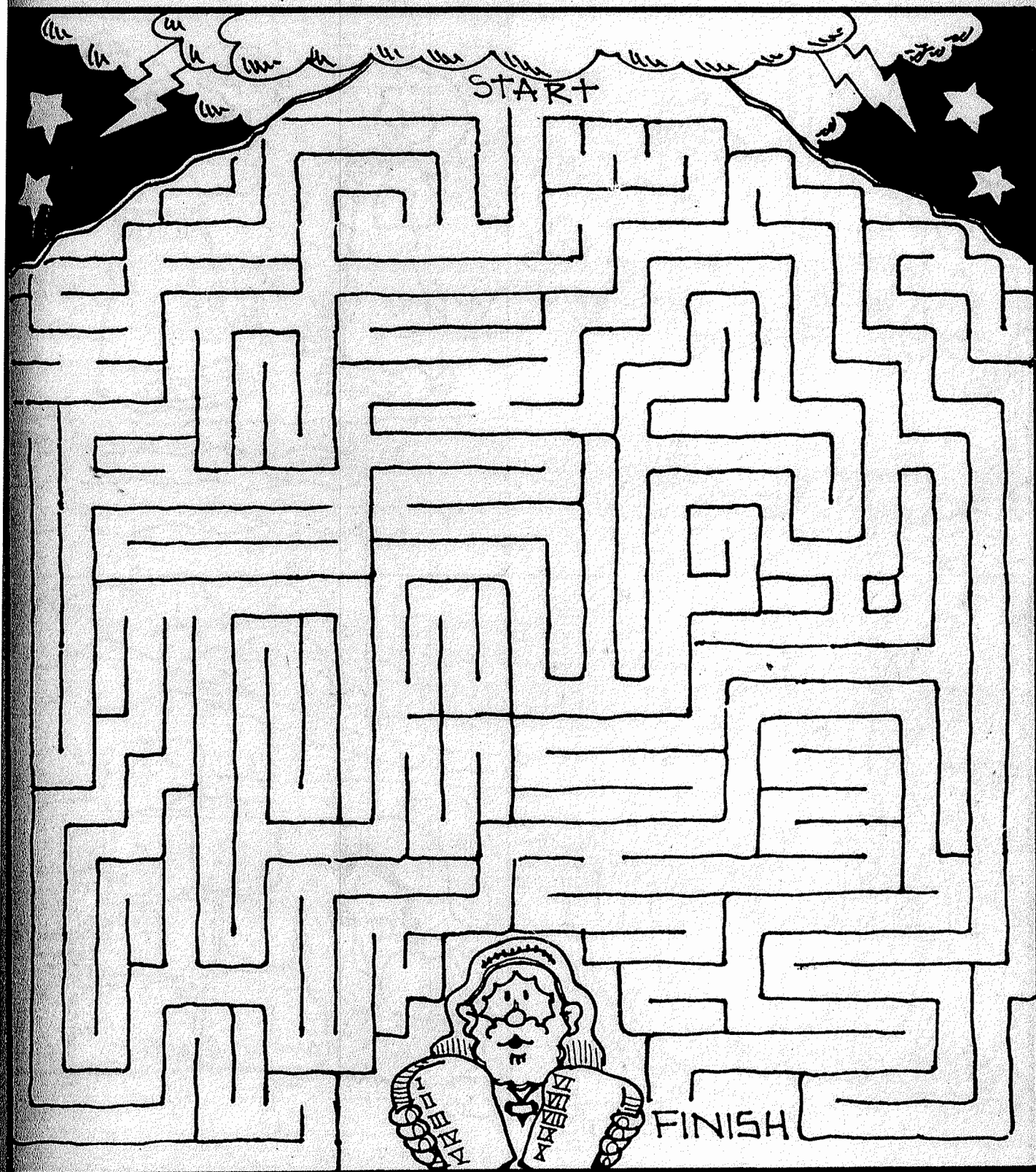


### ***Exodus 32:19***

## THE TEN COMMANDMENTS



The Israelites were waiting for Moses to come down from the top of Mount Sinai. Moses was on top of the mountain listening to what God wanted him

to share with the people.

God told Moses ten commandments that he wanted the Israelites to follow. The commandments are like rules for God's people. The ten commandments are:

1. Do not worship any other god.
2. Do not worship idols.
3. Do not misuse the Lord's name.
4. Keep the Sabbath day holy.
5. Honor your father and mother.
6. Do not murder.
7. Do not commit adultery.
8. Do not steal.
9. Do not lie.
10. Do not covet.

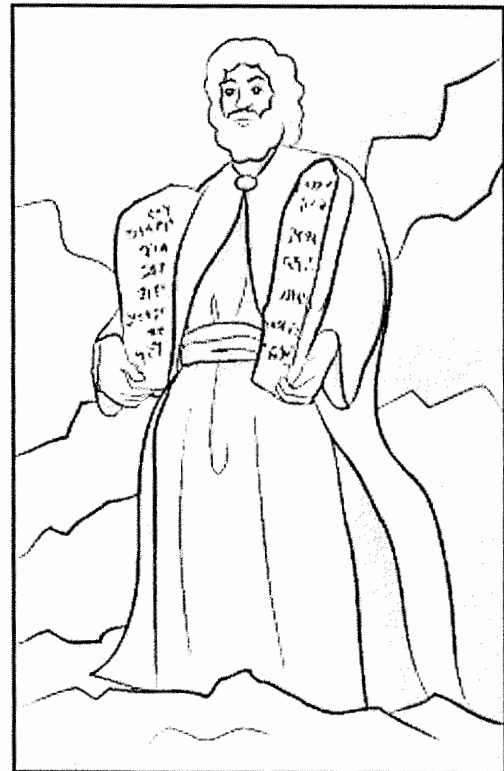
# The 10 Commandments

(Exodus 20:1-17 NIV)

God brought the Israelites to Mount Sinai and God spoke to Moses from the mountain. This is what God said:

"Now if you obey me fully  
and keep my covenant. . .

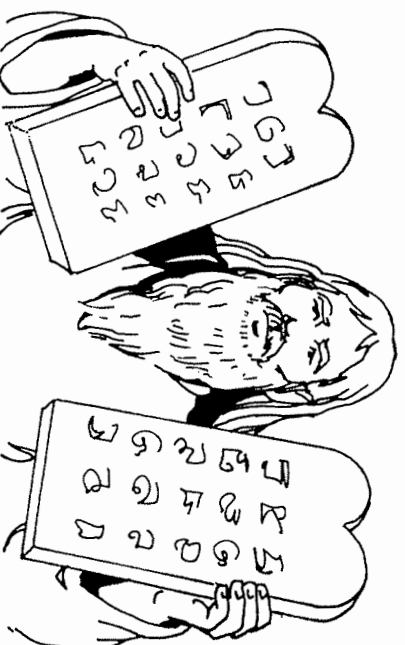
