
Week 43 Silver Trumpets and Israelite Grumblers


Scriptures: Numbers 10 - 11

Key Verse: Numbers 11:1 Now when the people complained it displeased the Lord; for the Lord heard it and His anger was aroused.

Key Points:

- 1. God commanded that 2 silver trumpets be made. They were to be for the calling of the assembly and for directing the movement of the camps. They were also to be blown during appointed feasts and over offerings and sacrifices.
- 2. The cloud was lifted from above the tabernacle and they set out on their journeys from the Wilderness of Sinai to the Wilderness of Paran. This was the first time the tabernacle was moved. The children of Israel were set out in groups to march, with the ark in the covenant going before them.
- 3. The people grumbled about their food. They missed the tasty food they had in Egypt. They whined, wanting meat to eat. God burned with anger because of their grumbling. Moses was frustrated with them and went to God for help.
- **4.** God told Moses he would send quail for them to eat for a whole month. They would have so much quail that it would come out their nostrils and they would loathe it. He did this because they despised the Lord and grumbled against Him. A wind went out from the Lord and brought the quail. It covered 20 miles and was 3 feet high.
- 5. They ate the quail greedily. The Lords wrath came against them and he struck them with a plague. Many were sick and died. We should be careful of our grumbling and complaining for it is not pleasing to God.






"Make two trumpets of silver for yourself. You shall make them of beaten work. And they shall be used for the calling of the assembly and for the journeying of the camps. And when they shall blow with them, all the assembly shall gather themselves to you at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation." Numbers 10:2-3




These trumpets were to be blown for different reasons; for calling an assembly of the people, for journeying of the camps, for gathering the princes of the tribes or to blow an alarm.



The sons of Aaron, the Priests, were to blow the trumpets by an ordinance (or law) forever. Also they were to be blown before going to war against an enemy who attacks them, and they would be saved from their enemies.



Also in the day of your gladness, and in your appointed feasts, and in the beginnings of your months, you shall blow with the silver trumpets over your burnt offerings, and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings, so that they may be to you for a memorial before your God. I am the LORD your God." Numbers 10:10




Easy Trumpet Music Craft

- 3 buttons








Directions:

- 3. Glue on 3 buttons on the top.


