
The Twelve Spies

Scriptures: Numbers 13 and 14

Key Verse: Numbers 14:8 If the Lord delights in us, then He will bring us into this land and give it to us, a land which flows with milk and honey.


Key Points:

- 1. God commands Moses to send 12 spies to spy out the promised land (Canaan). One man from each tribe is selected. They spend 40 days in Canaan.
- 2. Joshua and Caleb bring back a good report of faithfulness while the other 10 spies bring back an evil report to Moses. The evil report stirred up the people and they became fearful. Caleb quieted them and encouraged the congregation to take possession of the land.
- 3. The children feared and cried and complained against Moses and Aaron. They also accused God of delivering them to the promised land only to be destroyed. They desired someone to lead them back to Egypt. Joshua and Caleb encouraged the people not to rebel.
- **4.** God was angry enough to destroy the children of Israel who complained (even though they had seen the mighty deliverance from Egypt). Moses prayed to God to pardon them. God said that He would save everyone age 19 and under as well as Joshua and Caleb.
- **5.** The 10 spies who gave evil reports all died immediately from the plague God sent. The people decided to try to enter the promised land against God's Word and they were attacked by the Amalekites and Canaanite enemies.




10. The Cluster of Grapes


