Poisonous Snakes

Scriptures: Numbers 21

Key Verse: Numbers 21:8 Then the Lord said to Moses, "Make a fiery serpent, and set it on a pole and it shall be that everyone who is bitten, when he looks at it, shall live."

Key Points:

- 1. The children of Israel were very discouraged and unappreciative in their attitude. They accused Moses and said they did not have food or water. They also said they hated the manna that God was providing for their food (angels' food).
- 2. God sent poisonous serpents into the camp and they bit many of them and they died.
- **3.** The people admitted that they had sinned against Moses and God. They repented and asked Moses to pray to God for the snakes' removal from the camp.
- **4.** God instructed Moses what to do to remedy the snake bites. God told Moses to make a fiery serpent and set it on a pole. He crafted one out of bronze and lifted it up on a pole. Everyone who was bitten by a poisonous snake and looked on the bronze serpent was saved!

The Israelites disobeyed God many imes. One of the times they had lispleased God. He told them they would have to wander in the wilderness or forty years.

While they were wandering, the sraelites came to Mount Hor. It was on his mountain that God chose a new righ priest, Eleazar, to serve Him. It was also here that Aaron died. Aaron had served God for many years, but he lied before he could go into the land of Canaan, because he had disobeyed God.

After the Israelites left Mount Hor, they began to talk against God and Moses. God punished them for speaking against Him and for not being thankful for all He had done for them. He sent fiery serpents to bite them and many Israelites died.



Finally, when the Israelites knew they had done wrong and were sorry, God told Moses to make a serpent out of brass and put it on a pole. All who looked at the brass serpent were saved.
