Balaam, the Donkey, And The Angel

Scriptures: Numbers 22, 23, and 24

Key Verse: Numbers 22:33 "The donkey saw Me and turned aside from me these three times. If she had not turned aside from Me, surely I would also have killed you by now, and let her live."

Key Points:

- 1. The Israelites camped in the land of Moab across from Jericho. Balak, king of Moab was very fearful of them because they were very numerous, very victorious, and because of the news of their Egyptian deliverance.
- 2. Balak wished to hire Balaam the prophet to curse God's people so he could drive them out and defeat them. He sent messengers to entice Balaam. Balak offered Balaam great honor and riches.
- **3.** God's anger was kindled against Balaam because Balaam traveled with Balak's messengers to meet the king.
- **4.** As Balaam traveled, his donkey turned aside when she saw the Angel of the Lord so Balaam struck her. Again the donkey smashed Balaam's foot against a wall trying to turn from the angel so Balaam struck her a second time. A third time, the donkey laid down under Balaam to avoid the angel of the Lord and Balaam struck her.
- 5. God opened the mouth of the little donkey and she spoke to Balaam and then the Lord opened Balaam's eyes to see the Angel of the Lord with His sword drawn. Balaam fell on his face before the angel and confessed his sin. He proceeded on his trip and blessed Israel 4 times instead of cursing Israel as Balak, king of Moab had wanted.

"And the LORD opened the mouth of the ass, and she said unto Balaam, What have I done unto thee, that thou hast smitten me these three times?" NUMBERS 22:28




