
#### Walls Of Jericho

Scriptures: Joshua 6, 7, and 8

Key Verses: Joshua 6:20 So the people shouted when the priests blew the trumpets. And it happened when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, and the people shouted with a great shout that the wall fell down flat. Then the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they took the city.

#### **Key Points:**

- 1. Jericho was all closed up with no one going in or out, but God gave Jericho into the hands of Joshua and the Israelites.
- 2. The men of war of Israel marched once a day around the city walls for 6 days. Each day, seven priests each carried a trumpet of ram's horn before the ark of the covenant. On the seventh day, (with the armed men, priests and the ark of the covenant in the lead) they circled the city seven times. When the priests blew along blast on the trumpets the people shouted at Joshua's instruction. The walls fell in flat and they entered the city.
- 3. Rahab and all within her house were spared because she hid the two spies. All the other inhabitants were killed and Jericho was burned with fire.
- **4.** Achan took some accursed things instead of giving the silver, gold, bronze, and iron to the Lord. He and his household were killed because of their sin.
- 5. The Israelites had 36 people killed in their next battle (the first attempt to capture the city of Ai) because of Achan's sin. The second attempt on Ai was successful as God gave them the city.




Joshua at Jericho Joshua 5, 6

Cut two ram's horns per child from tagboard. Punch holes as indicated. Do two horns at once so the holes will match. Tie one end of a piece of yarn through the two horns. Dip the other end of the yarn in white glue, twist to a point, and allow to dry. Let the children decorate their horns before sewing them. Leave the large end open so the horn can be stuffed with tissue paper or newspaper.

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
Fold the tagboard into cubes and tape shut. Glue pictures or words on each face of both cubes so they are identical. For example, city, wall, horn, men, yell, Joshua. Let the children take turns tossing the cubes into the air and letting them land on a table. 
# Seven Times Around
