
Gibeonites Fool Joshua

Scriptures: Joshua 9

Key Verse: Joshua 9:14 Then the men of Israel took some of their provisions; but they did not ask counsel of the LORD.

Key Points:

- 1. The Gibeonites had heard about the God of Israel and they were afraid for their lives.
- **2.** A group of Gibeonites went to see Joshua to try to make peace with the Israelites.
- **3.** They lied to the Israelites, saying they had traveled from a great distance. Their worn out clothes, tattered wineskins and moldy bread made the lie seem possible.
- **4.** The Israelites made an agreement with the Gibeonites without asking God.
- **5.** Three days later, the Israelites realized they had been tricked.
- **6.** The Israelites kept their promise not to harm the Gibeonites, and they became woodcutters and water carriers to serve Israel.
