Gideon and the Angel

Scriptures: Judges 6

Key Verse: Judges 6:12 And the angel of the LORD appeared to him and said, "The LORD is with you, you mighty man of valor!"

Key Points:

1. The Midianites were enemies of Israel who came and destroyed the crops of the Israelites. The Israelites were starving, and tried to hide their remaining food supplies. They cried out to the Lord.

2. God sent an angel to Gideon while he was threshing wheat in a winepress. He told Gideon that God had chosen him to defeat the Midianites.


3. Gideon asked for a sign and prepared an offering of meat and unleavened bread. Fire consumed the offering and the angel disappeared.

4. God instructed Gideon to tear down the idol of Baal that the people worshipped and build an altar to God. Because he was afraid of the people, Gideon did this at night. Afterwards the people wanted to kill Gideon. Joash, Gideon's father reminded them that if Baal was a real god, he could punish Gideon himself.

5. Gideon asked God for another sign. He put a piece of fleece (wool) on the ground. The first time he asked for it to be wet and the ground around it to be dry. The next time he asked for the fleece to be dry while the ground was wet. God did so. Gideon was convinced and ready to fight.





Gideon Is Brave




Even though God had chosen him, Gideon was scared. An angel came to him and said, "Don't be afraid. God is with you, mighty warrior!"



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

What a strange list of words! See how these words fit together by reading the story of Gideon in Judges 6, 7, and 8. Then fit the words in the puzzle.




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Impossible Odds


