## Jepthah's Daughter

Scriptures: Judges 10, 11

Key Verse: Judges 11:36 "My father, if you have given your word to the LORD, do to me according to what has gone out of your mouth"

### **Key Points:**

- 1. Jepthah was forced out of his home by his brothers because he had a different mother.
- 2. Later, when the people of Ammon made war against Israel, the leaders asked Jepthah to lead them in battle. He agreed, but with the understanding that he would become their judge if the Lord gave him victory over Ammon.
- 3. Jepthah tried to reason with the king of Ammon that God had given the lands of the Moabites and the Amorites to Israel hundreds of years ago, and that Ammon had no claim to them. The king refused to listen.
- 4. Before going into battle, Jepthah promised God that if Israel won he would dedicate to God whoever met him on his return.
- 5. When Jepthah came home, his only child met him to celebrate the victory. Sadly, he told her his promise.
- 6. She asked for two months to mourn that she would never marry or have children. Then she was dedicated to serve God the rest of her life.

## A noble, but unnecessary Vow!




Have the children draw their own picture of Jeptha's daughter in mourning. As they draw you can discuss with them the importance of not making rash decisions and vows.
