
### God Answers Hannah's Prayer

Key Verse: I Samuel 1:27 "For this child I prayed, and the lord has grated my petition which I asked of him."


### **Key Points:**

- **1.** Elkanah had two wives, Hannah and Peninnah. Peninnah had children but Hannah did not.
- 2. Yearly they would go to worship at Shilo to worship and sacrifice. Elkanah would give portions of meat to Peninnah and her children but gave Hannah a double portion because of his deep love for her. Peninnah would provoke her because she had no children so Hannah would not eat or drink in her distress.
- **3.** One day, when at the tabernacle for sacrifice, Hannah was earnestly praying. With many tears, she prayed for a child, promising God that if she had a child, she would give him to the Lord and never cut his hair. Eli, the priest, was in the doorway watching her. He thought she was drunk and asked her why she was acting that way. She told him she was in sorrow and not drunk.
- **4.** Eli told her to "Go in peace" and that god would grant her prayer. She went home and in time gave birth to a son. She called him Samuel. When he was weaned, Hannah took him and presented him to the Lord.
- **5.** Samuel worked in the tabernacle before the Lord, learning from Eli the priest. His mother would bring him a new robe each year as they came for the yearly sacrifice. Eli would bless them for giving Samuel to the Lord. Hannah kept her promise to the Lord and He blessed her. She had 3 more sons and 2 daughters.
- **6.** Our prayers are important to God. He listens and blesses us as we follow His directions for our lives.




