#### God Gives His People a King

Scriptures: I Samuel 8, 9, 10

Key Verse: I Samuel 10:19 'But you have now rejected your God, who saves you out of all your calamities and distresses. And you have said "No, set us a king over us." So now present yourselves by your tribes and clans.'

#### **Key Points:**

- 1. When Samuel grew old he appointed his sons, Joel and Abijah, as judges. They did not walk with God, they were unruly and dishonest. Because of this, the elders of Israel begged for a king. They wanted a king as all the other nations had. This displeased Samuel, thinking they were rejecting him, but God told him it was HIM they were rejecting.
- 2. Samuel made it clear to the people what would happen if they had a king. (go over ch. 8:10-17) The people refused to listen. He went to the Lord and He told Samuel to let them have their way, give them a king.
- **3.** A Benjamite man, named Kish, was an upstanding man. He had a son, Saul, an impressive man who stood head and shoulders taller than any others. His father sent him and his servants to search for some lost donkeys. They traveled a long way, searching. Fearing his father would be worried about them, Saul decided to return home but did not know which way to go. Hearing a man of God was in town, they went to Samuel for advice.
- **4.** God had told Samuel he would send a man from the town of Benjamin, a few days before. Saul came to Samuel. As he sees him, he knows this is the man God had been talking about. He took him to a hall and gave him the seat of honor where about 30 were seated. He gave him meat to eat and Saul dined with Samuel.
- 5. They left the hall and walked down the edge of town. Samuel sent his servants on so he could give Saul a message from God. He took a flask of oil and poured it on Saul's head, kissed him, anointing him as king. Saul was 30 years old.

- **6.** Samuel told Saul all that would happen to him. God would change his heart and His Spirit would come to Saul in power, in prophesying, that he would be a different person. He told him when these things were fulfilled, he was to do whatever his hand found to do, for God would be with him.
- 7. Samuel gathered all the people of Israel together. He told them God had brought them out of Egypt and delivered them but they had rejected Him as their God. They had asked for a king so God was going to deliver one. Samuel had the tribes of Israel to present themselves. He called out the tribe of Benjamin. Then Saul, son of Kish was chosen. When they called him, he was not to be found. He was hiding in the baggage. They ran and brought him out and when he stood up, he was head and shoulders taller. The people shouted, "Long live the king!" There were some men who were troublemakers who despised Saul, they brought him no gifts but Saul kept silent.
- **8.** God knew a king would not be good for Israel but they would not listen. We should be willing to read God's word and listen to what he has for us to do.



Saul was anointed by Samuel and became the first king of the Hebrews.

# A King for Israel:


