#### **David Plans a House For God**

Scriptures: 2 Samuel 7 and 1 Chronicles 17 and 22

Key Verse: 1 Chronicles 22:19 "Now set your heart and your soul to seek the Lord your God. Therefore arise and build the sanctuary of the Lord God, to bring the ark of the covenant of the Lord and the holy articles of God into the house that is to be built for the name of the Lord."

### **Key Points:**

- 1. King David was living at peace in Jerusalem in a fine, cedar house. He realized that the ark of God was kept in a tent. He told God's Prophet, Nathan, that he wanted to build a fine house for God.
- 2. God's words and vision through Nathan were thus:
  - a. I took you from the sheepfold.
  - b. I have never asked to have a house built for me. I moved about with Israel.
  - c. You will not build Me a house-I will build an eternal house for you, i.e. from your descendants will come the everlasting King of Kings. This spiritual "house" would show God's selection of David's family as royal. His generations would bring forth the Messiah, Jesus.
  - d. Your son, Solomon, will build an earthly house for the ark because you have shed much blood.
- 3. Instead of being disappointed, David praised God and stored up all manner of building materials for Solomon, his peaceful son. He gathered gold, silver, bronze, cedar wood, artisans, and workers for the magnificent temple. He encouraged all Israel to arise and work.





Then Nathan said to the king, "Go, do all that is in your heart, for the Lord is with you."



### Making the Ark of the Covenant

o Children can make their own Ark of the Covenant with a shoe box. With a hole punch, make holes on both sides of both ends of the shoe box. Punch the holes about 1 inch below the top edge. Make sure that the holes are below the edge of the lid. Insert two dowels through the holes, so that each dowel goes all the way through the box and extends out the other side. Paint the shoe box and its lid gold, inside and out. Direct children to glue a gold bead to each corner of the bottom of the box for legs, and then to glue gold braid to the sides of the lid for decoration. Cut out two kneeling angels and have children glue them to the lid of the box. While the children are constructing their Arks, talk about how people who love God can be a living Ark and carry blessings to the world around us.
