December 4, 2025 - Since broadening my ministry efforts in Oklahoma beyond the Putnam City congregation beginning September of this year, in order to discover and aid additional congregations I have visited three so far - Estes Park, Britton Road and South Penn. Estes Park and Britton Road meet in neighborhoods in close proximity to my home. Since I have bought a house in this area of town and seek to build community here, it seems most logical to get to know these brethren.

Both Estes and Britton practice professional preacher traditions, have established elderships and use deacons. I have visited Estes Park twice and Brighton Road five times. A couple of other Sundays and every Wednesday since mid September I have joined Holly in assembling with the South Penn congregation who practice a multiple man preaching tradition (mutual ministry model). It has been our family practice, since filling the role of evangelist, to decide on a home base for Holly (and Zoe) to identify and meet weekly with. After several visits and a sit down with one of South Penn's elders, Holly and I have decided to make South Penn this base for her. I plan to assemble with her monthly.

South Penn presents an interesting relationship as a mutual ministry congregation that to my knowledge has been mostly unfamiliar to the mutual ministry fellowship of congregations in Missouri, Kansas, Colorado and California that I have ministered among since 2009. South Penn has a fellowship of at least two other congregations that I know of in the Oklahoma City metro and others in Oklahoma and Texas. There has been and now is a growing awareness among what seems like only a few in both fellowships of one another. It will be interesting to see how this relationship develops.

Concerning Estes Park and Britton Road. Familiarity is being built, relationships with the general membership and leadership are being formed, discussions about the organization, practice and ministry of each is being discussed and the mutual ministry pattern of the church is being introduced.

My service to the Putnam City church currently continues in the form of conducting discipleship studies with their new sister in Christ Sunny Pyle (see Think Souls Without Ceasing posts).

Your prayers for wisdom, discernment and fruitfulness in these efforts to God's glory, brethren's good to the increase of the Kingdom are welcome.
