I was blessed to spend a Sunday with the congregations at Lone Jack, Meadville, and Murray Road over the last 6 months. I thank them for the opportunity to meet with them and to bring a sermon to them. I hope and pray that my thoughts were helpful to them, as their kindness was to me.
